

Sacrament of Baptism

Due to scheduling and availability, please allow at least six weeks between the initial contact for Baptism and the intended Baptism date. Parents must be registered parishioners for at least 3 months and attend a Baptism preparation class. Contact Pam Brelage in the office at 765-288-6180 or at st.francismunciedre@gmail.com to register for the class and to schedule the ceremony.

Marriage Preparation

Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. Call the office to arrange a time with a priest for your initial meeting. Students: Marriage preparation may begin here even though the marriage may be celebrated elsewhere.

Ministry to Sick & Shut-Ins

Notify the office if you are going into the hospital or if you would like the Sacrament of the Sick, Communion or visitation at home. A priest from St. Francis of Assisi will visit you in the hospital if you inform the office at the time of hospitalization.

MISSION STATEMENT

As a part of the Local Church of Northcentral Indiana, we the people of St. Francis of Assisi Parish are called to fulfill our mission as a University Parish and Newman Center. FOCUS

I find it quite amusing how critical other generations are of the millennial generation. After all, the older generations were responsible for the nurturing and mentoring of the younger generations. Perhaps we ought to be more critical of ourselves than cast blame and denunciation on the younger generation. Even better, we can assess the critical situation this has created for the Church. Demographers are in a panic over the fact that the Millennials are not having their children baptized or confirmed in the Church. The young seem to have departed.

The immediate question, then, is "Who has the skill and wherewithal to approach the most difficult demographic in the community, young people, with the ability to touch their lives and change their hearts?" I ask this with complete candor, knowing that a great many in the Church have tried... and a great many in the Church have failed. It is not easy.

This is exactly why I admire and support the work of FOCUS: Fellowship of Catholic University Students. These young missionaries are doing the work that many Catholics are afraid to do: they are in the dorms, fraternities, gyms, coffee houses, and libraries of the University seeking those who may be lost or disenfranchised and inviting them into a relationship with Jesus Christ and his Church.

Just recently, many of our own students returned from SEEK, an epic gathering of FOCUS university students from around the world. Our own students, although physically exhausted, have returned to us more spiritually alive and now begin the work of spreading the grace and favor they received with their peers. Actually, I have hope that the faith and excitement of our FOCUS participants might spread and touch all our lives. These young people are good and holy and filled with joy (and, yes, do mission work to the poor around the country as well!).

The experience of SEEK is incredible: 13,000 young people gathered to learn, share and pray. One of the most impressive experiences is Eucharistic Adoration when thousands kneel and pray to Our Lord in the Eucharist. Others reported extremely long lines of students seeking to go to Confession. One of our students estimated that the line, if all stretched out, must have been a mile long. Many speak of new friendship, not only with other university students, but with Jesus Christ. Their love and fellowship with Christ is authentic and genuine.

St. Francis is in the game as well.! Our Campus Minister, Sarah Striebich, has redesigned our weekly liturgy and activity schedule to more fully address the needs of today's university student. She, in consultation with many others, hope to reach many new students and further our reach on the University campus. I would invite anyone to join the students in prayer and celebration of the Sacraments. Our student parishioners genuinely appreciate your presence. May God bless all our endeavors.
