YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST
NOVEMBER 21, 2021 - OCTOBER 7, 2022

The Year of the Eucharist is an initiative of the Diocese of Springfield to inspire and cultivate a deeper understanding and practice of the real presence of the Eucharist.

What is the Eucharist?

Source and Summit - Following the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, the Eucharist is the sacrament that completes a Christian’s initiation in the Church. Christ instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper with his disciples, the night before his death, to perpetuate the sacrifice of the Cross. This sacrament is “the source and summit of the Christian life” (Lumen Gentium): Everything that we think, believe, pray, and do is oriented toward the Eucharist.

Body and Blood - At the heart of the Eucharist are the bread and wine that become the Body and Blood of Christ during Mass. Bread and wine have a rich heritage in Scripture—we see these same humble staples in the harvest firstfruits, the manna in the desert, the wine at the wedding in Cana, and the loaves Jesus multiplied to feed thousands. At the Last Supper, our Lord used these ordinary elements of bread and wine to institute the Eucharist (Matthew 26:17-30; Mark 14:12-25; Luke 22:7-23), a new Passover (see Exodus 12). The Church represents Christ’s sacrifice on the cross and commemorates his death and resurrection with every celebration of the Eucharist, in anticipation of Christ’s coming kingdom.

Holy Mass - The Mass has two main parts, the liturgy of the Word (gathering, readings, homily, and intercessions) and the liturgy of the Eucharist (presentation of bread and wine, consecration, and communion).

Mystical Body of Christ - The term “Body of Christ” is used in two different but related senses. The first sense, more specifically called the Eucharistic Body of Christ, refers to the fact that the consecrated bread and wine are the resurrected and glorified body of Jesus Christ. The second sense refers to the Church itself: members of the Church, who are the Body of Christ, have Christ as their head. This second sense is sometimes called the Mystical Body of Christ. The Mystical Body of Christ includes both the living and the dead. The Eucharistic and Mystical Body of Christ are linked—we are brought together as the Church when we receive Christ in the Eucharist.

AÑO DE LA EUCARISTÍA

21 NOVIEMBRE 2021 - 7 OCTUBRE 2022

El Año de la Eucaristía es una iniciativa de la Diócesis de Springfield para inspirar y cultivar una comprensión y práctica más profunda de la presencia real de la Eucaristía. Se desarrollará del 21 de noviembre de 2021 al 7 de octubre de 2022.

¿Qué es la Eucaristía?

Fuente y cumbre - Tras los sacramentos del Bautismo y la Confirmación, la Eucaristía es el sacramento que completa la iniciación del cristiano en la Iglesia. Cristo instituyó la Eucaristía en la Última Cena con sus discípulos, la noche antes de su muerte, para perpetuar el sacrificio de la Cruz. Este sacramento es "la fuente y la cumbre de la vida cristiana" (Lumen Gentium): Todo lo que pensamos, creemos, rezamos y hacemos está orientado hacia la Eucaristía.


Cuerpo y Sangre - En el corazón de la Eucaristía están el pan y el vino que se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo durante la Misa. El pan y el vino tienen una rica herencia en las Escrituras: vemos estos mismos humildes alimentos en las primicias de la cosecha, el maná en el desierto, el vino en las bodas de Caná y los panes que Jesús multiplicó para alimentar a miles de personas. En la Última Cena, nuestro Señor utilizó estos elementos ordinarios de pan y vino para instituir la Eucaristía (Mateo 26:17-30; Marcos 14:12-25; Lucas 22:7-23), una nueva Pascua (véase Éxodo 12). La Iglesia vuelve a representar el sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz y conmemora su muerte y resurrección con cada celebración de la Eucaristía, en anticipación del reino venidero de Cristo.

Santa Misa - La Misa tiene dos partes principales, la liturgia de la Palabra (reunión, lecturas, homilía e intercesiones) y la liturgia de la Eucaristía (presentación del pan y el vino, consagración y comunión).

Cuerpo místico de Cristo - El término "Cuerpo de Cristo" se utiliza en dos sentidos diferentes pero relacionados. El primer sentido, más específicamente llamado Cuerpo Eucarístico de Cristo, se refiere al hecho de que el pan y el vino consagrados son el cuerpo resucitado y glorificado de Jesucristo. El segundo sentido se refiere a la Iglesia misma: los miembros de la Iglesia, que son el Cuerpo de Cristo, tienen a Cristo como cabeza. Este segundo sentido se denomina a veces Cuerpo Místico de Cristo. El Cuerpo Místico de Cristo incluye tanto a los vivos como a los muertos. El Cuerpo Eucarístico y el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo están vinculados: nos reunimos como Iglesia cuando recibimos a Cristo en la Eucaristía.

ROK E EUCHARYSTII

21 LISTOPADA 2021 R. - 7 PAŹDZIERNIKA 2022 R.

Rok Eucharystii jest inicjatywą Diecezji Springfield, aby zainspirować i kultywować głębsze zrozumienie i praktykowanie prawdziwej obecności Eucharystii.

Czym jest Eucharystia?

Źródło i Szczyt - Po sakramentach chrztu i bierzmowania, Eucharystia jest sakramentem, który dopełnia inicjację chrześcijanina w Kościele. Chrystus ustanowił Eucharystię podczas Ostatniej Wieczerzy ze swoimi uczniami, w noc poprzedzającą Jego śmierć, aby utrwalić ofiarę Krzyża. Ten sakrament jest "źródłem i szczytem życia chrześcijańskiego" (Lumen Gentium): Wszystko, co myślimy, w co wierzymy, co się modlimy i co czynimy jest ukierunkowane na Eucharystię.


Ciało i Krew - W sercu Eucharystii znajdują się chleb i wino, które stają się Ciałem i Krwią Chrystusa podczas Mszy Świętej. Chleb i wino mają bogate dziedzictwo w Piśmie Świętym - widzimy te same skromne zsywki w pierwszych owocach żniwa, mannie na pustyni, winie na weselu w Kanie Galilejskiej i w bochenkach, które Jezus rozmnożył, by nakarmić tysiące. Podczas Ostatniej Wieczerzy nasz Pan użył tych zwyczajnych elementów chleba i wina, aby ustanowić Eucharystię (Mt 26, 17-30; Mk 14, 12-25; Łk 22, 7-23), nową Paschę (zob. Wj 12). Kościół uobecnia ofiarę Chrystusa na krzyżu oraz upamiętnia Jego śmierć i zmartwychwstanie podczas każdej celebracji Eucharystii, w oczekiwaniu na przyjście Królestwa Chrystusa.

Msza Święta - Msza Święta składa się z dwóch głównych części: liturgii Słowa (zgromadzenie, czytania, homilia i wstawiennictwo) oraz liturgii Eucharystii (ofiarowanie chleba i wina, konsekracja i komunika).

Mistyczne Ciało Chrystusa - Termin "Ciało Chrystusa" jest używany w dwóch różnych, ale powiązanych ze sobą znaczeniach. Pierwsze znaczenie, bardziej szczegółowo nazywane Eucharystycznym Ciałem Chrystusa, odnosi się do faktu, że konsekrowany chleb i wino są zmartwychwstałym i uwielbionym ciałem Jezusa Chrystusa. Drugi sens odnosi się do samego Kościoła: członkowie Kościoła, którzy są Ciałem Chrystusa, mają Chrystusa za głowę. Ten drugi sens jest czasami nazywany Mistycznym Ciałem Chrystusa. Mistyczne Ciało Chrystusa obejmuje zarówno żywych, jak i umarłych. Eucharystyczne i Mistyczne Ciało Chrystusa są ze sobą powiązane - jesteśmy zjednoczeni jako Kościół, kiedy przyjmujemy Chrystusa w Eucharystii.
