

Saint Francis of Assisi

October 4
(1181 or 1182)

The patron saint of Italy, Francis of Assisi was a poor little man who astounded and inspired the Church by taking the gospel literally—not in a narrow fundamentalist sense, but by actually following all that Jesus said and did, joyfully, without limit, and without a sense of self-importance.

Serious illness brought the young Francis to see the emptiness of his frolicking life as leader of Assisi's youth. Prayer—lengthy and difficult—led him to a self-emptying like that of Christ, climaxed by embracing a leper he met on the road. It symbolized his complete obedience to what he had heard in prayer: “Francis! Everything you have loved and desired in the flesh it is your duty to despise and hate, if you wish to know my will. And when you have begun this, all that now seems sweet and lovely to you will become intolerable and bitter, but all that you used to avoid will turn itself to great sweetness and exceeding joy.”

From the cross in the neglected field-chapel of San Damiano, Christ told him, “Francis, go out and build up my house, for it is nearly falling down.” Francis became the totally poor and humble workman.

He must have suspected a deeper meaning to “build up my house.” But he would have been content to be for the rest of his life the poor “nothing” man actually putting brick on brick in abandoned chapels. He gave up all his possessions, piling even his clothes before his earthly father—who was demanding restitution for Francis’ “gifts” to the poor—so that he would be totally free to say, “Our Father in heaven.” He was, for a time, considered to be a religious fanatic, begging from door to door when he could not get money for his work, evoking sadness or disgust to the hearts of his former friends, ridicule from the unthinking.

But genuineness will tell. A few people began to realize that this man was actually trying to be Christian. He really believed what Jesus said: “Announce the kingdom! Possess no gold or silver or copper in your purses, no traveling bag, no sandals, no staff” (Luke 9:1-3).

Francis’ first rule for his followers was a collection of texts from the Gospels. He had no intention of founding an order, but once it began he protected it and accepted all the legal structures needed to support it. His devotion and loyalty to the Church were absolute and highly exemplary at a time when various movements of reform tended to break the Church’s unity.

Francis was torn between a life devoted entirely to prayer and a life of active preaching of the Good News. He decided in favor of the latter, but always returned to solitude when he could. He wanted to be a missionary in Syria or in Africa, but was prevented by shipwreck and illness in both cases. He did try to convert the sultan of Egypt during the Fifth Crusade. During the last years of his relatively short life, he died at 44, Francis was half blind and seriously ill. Two years before his death he received the stigmata, the real and painful wounds of Christ in his hands, feet and side.

On his deathbed, Francis said over and over again the last addition to his Canticle of the Sun, “Be praised, O Lord, for our Sister Death.” He sang Psalm 141, and at the end asked his superior’s permission to have his clothes removed when the last hour came in order that he could expire lying naked on the earth, in imitation of his Lord.

Reflection

Francis of Assisi was poor only that he might be Christ-like. He recognized creation as another manifestation of the beauty of God. In 1979, he was named patron of ecology. He did great penance—apologizing to “Brother Body” later in life—that he might be totally disciplined for the will of God. Francis’ poverty had a sister, Humility, by which he meant total dependence on the good God. But all this was, as it were, preliminary to the heart of his spirituality: living the gospel life, summed up in the charity of Jesus and perfectly expressed in the Eucharist.

Santa Faustina Kowalska 5 de octubre - (1905-1938)

El nombre de Santa Faustina está ligado para siempre a la fiesta anual y a la oración de la Divina Misericordia, que muchas personas rezan cada día a las tres de la tarde. Helena Kowalska, era la tercera de diez hijos. Trabajó como ama de llaves en tres ciudades antes de entrar en la Congregación de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia en 1925. Sirvió generosamente a las necesidades de las hermanas y de la población local, Sor Faustina también tenía una profunda vida interior. Esta incluía la recepción de revelaciones del Señor Jesús, mensajes que ella registraba en su diario a petición de Cristo y de sus confesores. Murió de tuberculosis en Cracovia, Polonia, el 5 de octubre de 1938. El Papa Juan Pablo II la beatificó en 1993 y canonizó en el 2000.



Nuestra Señora del Rosario 7 de octubre

San Pío V estableció esta fiesta en 1573. El objetivo era agradecer a Dios la victoria de los cristianos sobre los turcos en Lepanto, una victoria atribuida al rezo del rosario. Clemente XI extendió la fiesta a la Iglesia universal en 1716. El desarrollo del rosario tiene una larga historia. Primero se desarrolló la práctica de rezar 150 padrenuestros a imitación de los 150 salmos. Luego hubo una práctica paralela de rezar 150 Avemarías. Pronto, un misterio de la vida de Jesús se unió a cada Ave María. Aunque la entrega del rosario por parte de María a Santo Domingo se reconoce como una leyenda, el desarrollo de esta forma de oración debe mucho a los seguidores de Santo Domingo. Uno de ellos, Alan de la Roche, fue conocido como "el apóstol del rosario". Fundó la primera Cofradía del Rosario en el siglo XV. En el siglo XVI, el rosario se desarrolló hasta su forma actual, con los 15 misterios: gozosos, dolorosos y gloriosos. En 2002, el Papa Juan Pablo II añadió a esta devoción los cinco Misterios de la Luz.

San Francisco de Asís * 4 de octubre (1182-1226)

Francisco, hijo de un rico comerciante italiano, fue un playboy quien sufrió una profunda conversión luego de haber ido a la guerra por Asís; lo tomaron prisionero y sufrió una enfermedad muy debilitante. El renunció a su familia y a sus riquezas y vivió una vida de servicio y de pobreza total porque creía que así se lo había pedido Cristo. Fundó una nueva orden mendicante llamada Orden de los Frailes Menores o Franciscanos, y ayudó a fundar a las Clarisas y la Tercera Orden Franciscana. El papa Pío XII dijo que a Francisco se le podría llamar "un segundo Cristo" y, en el 2013, el Cardenal argentino Jorge Mario Bergoglio cuando fue elegido Papa tomó el nombre de este santo medieval. Francisco es el patrón de los animales, de los ambientalistas, de los comerciantes, de Acción Católica y de Italia.



Durante la Misa del 4 de octubre del 2013, el papa Francisco habló sobre las tres maneras en las cuales pensó que san Francisco pudiese ser un ejemplo para los católicos hoy. Él dijo: "1. La primera cosa que nos dice, la realidad fundamental que nos atestigua es esta: ser cristianos es una relación viva con la Persona de Jesús, es revestirse de él, es asimilarse a él... 2. La segunda cosa que Francisco nos atestigua: quien sigue a Cristo, recibe la verdadera paz, aquella que solo el, y no el mundo, nos puede dar... 3. El Santo de Asís da testimonio del respeto hacia todo lo que Dios ha creado y como El lo ha creado, sin experimentar con la creación para destruirla; ayudarla a crecer, a ser más hermosa y más parecida a lo que Dios ha creado.



Święty Franciszka z Asyżu 4 października 1881-1882 r.

Święty Franciszek jest jedną z najbardziej znanych postaci w hagiografii chrześcijańskiej, kochany i podziwiany w całym świecie, i to nie tylko przez chrześcijan. Osoba świętego Franciszka inspirowała pisarzy, poetów, literatów, artystów, historyków, polityków, reformatorów, rewolucjonistów, a nawet hipisów. Potomni nadali mu różne imiona: drugiego Chrystusa (Pius XI), ikony Chrystusa Ukrzyżowanego (Jan Paweł II), Biedaczyny z Asyżu, miłośnika Pani Biedy, zakochanego w miłości, Serafa z Asyżu, świętego pełnego wyrzeczenia, piewcy doskonałej miłości, brata Słońca, brata całego stworzenia i herolda Wielkiego Króla – Boga. To tylko niektóre, najbardziej znane przydomki świętego z Asyżu.

Urodził się w umbryjskim miasteczku Asyżu 1181 roku (inne źródła podają 1182). Był synem kupca Piotra Bernardone i Joanny Piki pochodzącej z Francji. Na chrzcie świętym otrzymał imię Jan, ale ojciec zdobniale i żartobliwie zwykł go nazywać Francesco i imię to przyłgnęło do niego na zawsze.

Był chłopcem szczerym i wielkodusznym, wrażliwym i uzdolnionym, muzykalnym, towarzyskim i radosnym. Po radosnej i bardziej lub mniej beztroskiej młodości, w dwudziestym piątym roku życia poczuł się przemieniony łaską Bożą. Porzucił wesołe życie i zaczął się zastanawiać jak mógłby zdobyć sławę. Jako młody człowiek Franciszek odznaczał się wrażliwością, lubił poezję, muzykę. Ubierał się dość ekstrawagancko, więc został okrzyknięty królem młodzieży asyjskiej.

Gdy miał 21 lat wziął udział w wojnie między Asyżem a Perugią {rok 1202} gdzie dostał się do niewoli. Prawie roczny pobyt w więzieniu poważnie nadwerężył jego zdrowie. Po powrocie do domu ciężko zachorował. Wówczas powziął zamiar zmiany życia. Nie był on jednak trwały. W roku 1205 uzyskał ostrogi rycerskie i udał się na wojnę, prowadzoną między Fryderykiem II a papieżem.

Najął zatem giermka, kupił konia i ruszył w świat. Ujechał sześćdziesiąt kilometrów i dotarł do Spoleto. Tu miał sen. Usłyszał głos: "Franciszku, komu lepiej służyć, Panu czy słudze?" Odpowiedział: "Panu". Przełamawszy wstyd, czym prędzej powrócił do Asyżu. Zmienił się. Poświęcał więcej czasu modlitwie, dawał hojne jałmużny, opiekował się chorymi. Przemianę tę przypisywał Bogu. Przewyciężył siebie i oddał się posłudze trędowatych. W "Testamencie" napisze: "Sam Pan wprowadził mnie wśród nich".



Najświętsza Maryja Panna Różańcowa. Nasza Pośredniczka

Przypadające dziś, 7 października, wspomnienie Najświętszej Maryi Panny Różańcowej to dzień szczególny w powszechnym i polskim kalendarzu maryjnym.

Październikowe nabożeństwo różańcowe odbywa się we wszystkich parafiach w Polsce. Modlitwa różańcowa jak żadna inna

obejmując cały świat katolicki wskazuje, że Maryja to Mater omnium, udzielająca się wszystkim we wszystkich potrzebach jako Pośredniczka prowadząca do Chrystusa. Różaniec stał się modlitwą powszechną, najdobitniejszym wyrazem czci i kultu maryjnego.

Interwencja Matki Bożej Powstanie święta łączy się z wydarzeniem militarnym, które miało wpływ na losy Europy. Ekspansja turecka na Morzu Śródziemnym została zatrzymana pod Lepanto. W dniu 7 października 1571 r. połączone floty Hiszpanii, Wenecji i Państwa Kościelnego pod wodzą Juana d'Austria pokonały flotę turecką. W tym samym dniu ulicami Rzymu kroczyła pod przewodnictwem Piusa V procesja odmawiając różaniec. Na czele procesji niesiono obraz Matki Boskiej Śnieżnej zwany Salus Populi Romani z bazyliki Santa Maria Maggiore w Rzymie.

Siostra Faustyna była zakonnicą, która wielką miłością ukochała Jezusa. Pan Jezus przemawiał do niej w jej duszy i uczynił ją apostołką Miłosierdzia Bożego. Przez św. Siostrę Faustynę Jezus przekazał nowe formy kultu Miłosierdzia Bożego: Obraz Jezusa Miłosiernego, Święto Miłosierdzia, Koronkę do Miłosierdzia Bożego, Godzinę Miłosierdzia oraz szerzenie czci Miłosierdzia.
