## *Sunday's Reflection*

Today's story of Lazarus has many rich dimensions. Lazarus had died. Each person involved, loving their brother, their friend, were mourning. And Jesus wept with them. Responding to their questions and doubt and blame, He tells them His reasons, His timing, the meaning of death and new life, His ultimate goals for us. They were given a deeper understanding of the love, wisdom and power of Jesus. Their mourning and their faith was enlightened, transformed. "Untie him, let him go." We too, in dying to our old self, can be given new life by Jesus. What in me needs to be untied? What keeps me bound? If you were Lazarus, raised to life by Jesus, what would your new life be like?

## From Father Galante

Dear friends,

The feasts of our salvation are drawing nearer! Holy Week is an action-packed, prayerful marathon of Our Lord's Paschal Mystery. The central event of our faith is celebrated with excruciating detail, and we are enriched and nourished in faith, hope, and love by re-presenting these mysteries. It could be said that the whole rest of the year is spent unpacking what happens during Holy Week.

At every Mass, we celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ. The entrance procession symbolizes the Lord's entry into the Holy City. The double consecration of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ re-present the mystical slaying of the Lord, who is sacrificed on the altar of the cross out of love and for our salvation. In the fraction rite, the Body and Blood of the Lord which were separated in death from his human soul, are commingled as a sign of his Resurrection when his soul and body were reunited. In the rite of Holy Communion, we receive Our Lord in his glorious and living flesh. By this we participate in his Ascension to Heaven, whereby he has made himself present to us in a new and powerful way through the Eucharist. This is truly what it means when we say the Eucharist is the pledge of future, heavenly glory!

Even still, the Church gives us one week of the year, every year, to remember and re-present in greater detail all of the events of Our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Sometimes, the sacramental actions throughout the year get lost on us, and so we need the greater focus of Holy Week to "bring home" the real moments of history that have saved and continue to save us.

Here is my appeal: Please come to all the liturgies of Holy Week! Make this year: the year that you go all in! Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday! Could we ever have too much time with God!? Each of the liturgies have their own purpose and place in drawing us deeper into the Paschal Mystery of Our Lord. They make great sense, all-fitted together. Especially if you have never attended an Easter Vigil, I want to personally recommend and invite you to give it a try!

The Church encourages even greater collaboration for the celebrations of the Sacred Triduum to intensify the solemnity of the liturgies. To that end, we have our two sites this year for the Triduum. Please consider joining us either at St. Andrew or at Sacred Heart for the Triduum. Thank you to all who will aid our worship in music, decorations, and ministries.

May this upcoming Holy Week be full of grace for each of us and bring great spiritual renewal to our parishes and the whole world!

**Celebrating 25 Years of Sacred Heart**

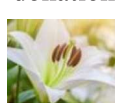
