



My dear friends,

Happy Easter! Christ is Risen - He is Risen Indeed!

We celebrate this utterly unthinkable miracle of God's goodness, the bodily Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. One of the powerful symbols and sacramentals of Easter is the newly blessed Holy Water. Besides being the way new Christians are reborn, it reminds all of us of our Baptism, and the fact that we have been personally joined to Christ in His Suffering, Death and Resurrection.

A favorite Scripture passage of mine is from the Book of the Prophet Ezekiel, chapter 47, verses 1-12, where he is experiencing a vision of the New Israel with the Temple in Jerusalem, and flowing water from its entrance. This stream eventually becomes a river and flows down to the lowest spot on earth - the Dead Sea - where it transforms the area from a place of death to a place of life, teeming with fish and fruit trees growing for healing and nourishment. The reality of the Jerusalem Temple points to Jesus Christ who said: "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up" (John 2:19). The vision of Ezekiel is fulfilled in Jesus' complete gift of Himself on the Cross when His side was pierced with a lance and blood and water flowed out. We see this moment of Good Friday, in particular, as the origin of the Sacramental life of the Church. For the Waters of Baptism transform fallen human nature from the aridness of sin and death to the hopeful place of new life, divine grace and the promise of heavenly life.

For 50 days of this Easter Season, we will have a chance to experience, enter into deeper communion with Jesus and the living waters of His divine life flowing from His side through the Sacraments of the Church.


What are the Dead Seas in our lives that we earnestly desire God to transform?

RENEW + REBUILD UPDATE



Goal: \$1,774,500 **Pledged:** \$2,374,413 **Paid:** \$2,092,402 **Balance:** \$202,790

Since our last report, the scaffolding and roaming cherry picker have left the premises. The last remaining task for the exterior work is to replace the church basement windows. To maintain an appropriate aesthetic for our 100+ year old church, new energy efficient windows are being are being custom manufactured to match the sizes and shapes of the existing windows. This will greatly improve the comfort of the space for the many school and parish activities, as well as lower the heating bill. The order has been placed and installation is scheduled to take place during the school summer break.

With the external repairs almost completed, we are now focusing on the interior painting and flooring replacement that were identified in the initial Renew + Rebuild specifications. We hope to also look at options to upgrade some materials and introduce better space utilization as the budget allows.
