### **Annulments: Fact vs. Fiction**

Isn't an annulment just a Catholic divorce? Will my children be considered illegitimate if I seek an annulment? I heard an annulment can cost thousands of dollars, is that true? Didn't Pope Francis just change the annulment process? How quickly can I get an annulment?

Recently, Pope Francis instituted some changes to the annulment process and many people are wondering how those changes might affect them.
