A Letter from Fr. Henry

Dear Parishioners, Priests, and Staff,

Thank you for all your prayers and expressions of concern over the past eight months. Your prayers truly helped me immensely to get through a very long healing process.

You may remember that last August I was hospitalized for a pulmonary embolism and operation. It took a lot out of me physically and I recovered slowly. I was regaining my strength for a while, and then started to lose it again. This started a downward spiral which led to burnout and very deep depression. That was when I asked the Archdiocese for help. I was placed on medical leave and sent away for treatment out of state.

Once there it was discovered that I was suffering with many of the same symptoms associated with post-traumatic stress disorder. I began a program to heal physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually. Your prayers sustained me through much of the recovery.


I am glad to be returning home. I will continue with my healing as an outpatient in a aftercare program.

Since Covid 19, I have not been out in the world so I have no real idea about what you have gone through except through the media. I am apprehensive about returning to a Covid world. I have restricted my time watching and reading about the virus, and know that I have much to learn.

I ask that you be patient with me, as I cannot allow myself to become overwhelmed by all that is on my plate when I return, July 4th weekend.

We have a huge debt of gratitude to Fr. Tierney, Fr. Thomas, Fr. Gabriel, Fr. Nicholas, and in the rectory Christine, Theresa and Brad. Also the parish council did an outstanding job in my absence and really stepped up to the plate. And special thanks to Bryan Healy and all the volunteers who have been helping with the communications on all levels.

Congratulations to Fr. Tierney who has been appointed as the Administrator of St. Gregory the Great parish in Harrison. Unfortunately, this means he will no longer be able to celebrate Mass with us on weekends. He assures me that once he is settled he will return to us for a Mass of Thanksgiving and a reception to offer him goodbyes and expressions of appreciation. I look forward to seeing all of you soon.

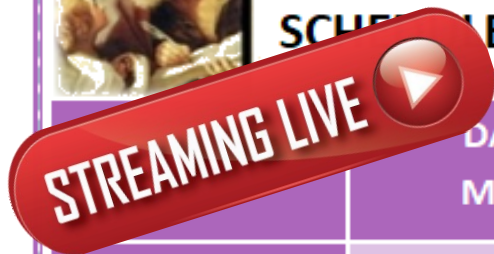

With simplicity, Jesus tells his apostles that everyone should love him above all others — father, mother, son or daughter. He adds, “He who welcomes you, welcomes me.”





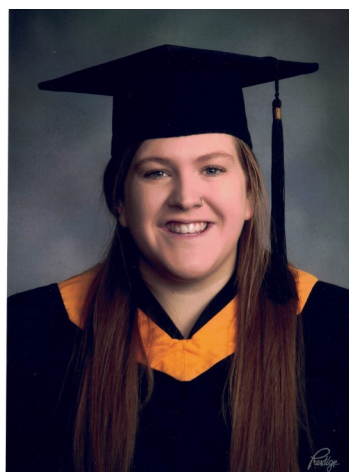

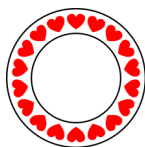
