Liturgical Music Notes – September 18, 2022 – Ordinary XXV

Every time we gather to celebrate Eucharist, we may sing a variety of texts and tunes: hymns, psalms, chants, anthems – but most importantly,

we sing the Mass Ordinary: words that do not change. Music paired with texts sung so frequently must be well-crafted to stand the test of time! After the introduction of vernacular languages into worship, composers came forward to make settings for non-Latin words now to be used at Mass. One of them was the Dutch composer Jan Vermulst (1925 – 1994), invited to create English Masses for the U.S. Catholic Church. Two of those continue to be mainstays in our parish: The *People's Mass* and *Mass for Christian Unity*.

Faith Formation Registration

Fall faith formation for our children and teens has begun but it's not too late to sign up! This registration is for the groups that meet on Sunday mornings, 9:30 – 10:45, including Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Confirmation Preparation and High School Bible Study. (No registration needed for Children's Liturgy of the Word or Nursery that meets during Mass.) If your child is preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation in Spring 2023, we will need additional information. Please complete the forms for these sacraments as well. First Communion News

Registration: Online registration for children who would like to receive their First Communion in Spring 2023 is available on our parish website, and paper registration forms are available in the back of the church. Please note: If your child is not in Catholic school, you will need to complete two forms (Sunday morning Faith Formation Registration AND First Communion)

Parents of 1st Graders: In the Diocese of Memphis, First Communion requires two years of preparation, either in the parish or Catholic school. If your child is not in Catholic school and would like to receive First Communion during Spring 2024, he/she will need to participate in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium sessions on Sunday mornings 9:30 – 10:45 AM. Please register him/her with the Faith Formation Registration form.

Registration: Online registration for youth who would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in Spring 2023 is available on our parish website, and paper registration forms are available in the back of the church. Please note: You will need to complete two forms (Sunday morning Faith Formation Registration AND Confirmation)

Parents of 7th Graders: In the Diocese of Memphis, Confirmation requires two years of preparation, either in the parish or Catholic school. If your child is not in Catholic school and would like to be confirmed in Spring 2024, he/she needs to participate in the Confirmation catechesis sessions for 7th and 8th graders on Sunday mornings at 9:30. Please register him/her with the Faith Formation Registration form (one form only for 7th graders.)
