STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

But Jesus tells us in the Gospel passage from Luke how we can discover the real answer to this question. He says, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

To discern what we really treasure, we need to do a check on our hearts. We can each ask ourselves, "Where do I spend the majority of my energy? Where do I find my thoughts dwelling? How do I choose to spend my time when I find myself with a few spare moments? What do my spending habits reveal about my what is important to me?

As Christian stewards, we are called to live our lives in grateful response to all that God has given us. Do I recognize and treasure these gifts?

Como corresponsables cristianos, estamos llamados a vivir nuestras vidas en respuesta agradecida a todo lo que Dios nos ha dado. ¿Reconozco y atesoro estos dones?


