

Saint Francis Home is a social ministry of the Catholic Diocese of
Richmond which provides an affordable, loving home and quality assisted care
for older adults who have limited financial means. Because our mission focuses on serving
those who cannot afford the high costs associated with assisted residential care, the funding gap
between the actual cost of care and the income we receive averages about \$1,200 per month
(or \$14,400 per year) for each of the Home's residents. As a result, Saint Francis Home depends
heavily on generous donations from the community to keep the doors open and to continue offering a wide
range of engaging programs and nurturing services to ensure our residents remain safe, happy, and healthy.
