- Develop and Maintain Programs aimed at evangelization in the heart of the gospel for all the People of God, but especially young people.
- Making significant investment in the capital improvement of the building (convert office space to preschool classrooms, convert the old parish hall into a gymnasium, install a playground, ball field and soccer field, convert the large meeting room and bridal room into a youth center for Junior High and High School students, and many other upgrades).
- Relocate All Saints Catholic School from its current location to the Center of Evangelization which involves the sale of the former School and Convent (excluding St. Mary Church.)
- Expand the Programs of Evangelization and Outreach.
- Invest in resources and endowments to meet the Evangelization goals of the Parish.

- Making a significant investment in the capital improvement in the Center of Catholic Charity (former St. Bernard School)
 - New Roof Improvements to Kitchen
 - Hygiene facilities for the homeless
 - Explore best use of space including the gymnasium
- Form a Charity Council to coordinate all charitable outreach inviting all Catholic entities including St. Vincent DePaul and Catholic Human Services.
- Emphasize the history of St. Bernard Church as the Mother Church with special events especially during the summer months.
- Recognize the Friendship Room as the anchor ministry of the Center of Catholic Charity with additional investment in resources and volunteers.
