

## From the desk of Fr. Kaim

#### Financial Peace University Coming to Holy Family!

We have been working with the Parish Success Group, our consultant that specializes in revitalizing Catholic parishes. One of the things they have done for us is gather census data within our parish boundaries. There are a couple of surveys from the U.S. Census Bureau which answers they have shared with us.

The Census surveys indicate that the top two issues that are on people's mind in our parish boundaries are finance and health. So we are going to begin to address those issues in a more aggressive way. My hope is to bring back some of our fallen away Catholics by offering things that might appeal to them. On any given Sunday, three out of four Catholics in this country (and our parish is close to that average) do not come to Mass. These are the folks we will be concentrating on bringing back to the faith. I am going to strategize with our parish nurse, Teresa Field, to expand our health services to you.

Regarding finances, one program that I was familiar with in the military is Financial Peace University, founded by Dave Ramsey. It is a very popular program that helps families manage their finances. Many folks have heard of it. You may have as well.

We will be offering their nine week course this fall,

tentatively beginning Thursday, September 12. The cost is \$109 per family. More to follow. Be sure to watch for the details in the coming months and let folks know about this.



#### Palm Sunday, Holy Week and "Hosanna!"

We are all familiar with the cry of the people of Jerusalem: "Hosanna!" It is said each year on Palm Sunday. According to St. Augustine, this is not a word, but rather an exclamation of one praying. It means "Save us, I implore you." It comes from "hosy," which means save and "anna," which means implore. This hearkens back to Isaiah 35:4: "Behold your God...He will come and save you."

"Hosanna" is a reminder that we are all in need of a savior. We Americans are sometimes just too selfsufficient and we forget that. We think we are accomplishing great things—on our own. My favorite of the Stations of the Cross are the ones based on the private revelations of St. Faustina. When Jesus falls for the second time, He tells St. Faustina, taken from her book Divine Mercy in My Soul: "The cause of your falls is that you rely too much upon yourself and too little on Me (1488). Know that of yourself you can do nothing (639). Without special help from Me, you are not even capable of accepting My graces (738)."

For that reason, it's incumbent on all of us to attend as many of the Holy Week liturgies as possible. The Triduum, as it is called, begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper. Actually, it begins earlier when all of us priests renew our vows and pick up the oils at the Cathedral of St. Peter. Then there's the Good Friday services where we not only repeat the Passion narrative, but reverence the Crucifix. And then we have the glory of the Easter liturgies beginning with the Easter Vigil followed by the usual complement of Easter Sunday Masses. Here's the line up:

Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Supper: 6:30 PM.

Good Friday, Celebration of the Lord's Passion: 12:30 and 6:30 PM.

Holy Saturday, Easter Vigil: 7:45 PM.

Easter Sunday: 6:30, 8:00, 9:30 & 11:00 AM and 12:30 PM. There will NOT be a 6:00 PM Mass.

I should point out that the start time of the Easter Vigil is tied to sundown. It begins in darkness and because of a somewhat late Easter, the earliest the Church allows this celebration is 7:45 PM.




#### **SPRED**—(Special Religious Development)
