And the future. And God. And faith. And their problems.





Weekend Coordinator

The role of the Weekend Coordinator is to create, plan, and manage the key elements required for a successful weekend experience at St. Pius X. The Weekend Coordinator's duties focus on managing the operation of the weekend Masses and working to ensure an "irresistible environment". They must be present at all worship experiences and maintain communication during the week. This position is a total of 19 hours, is not benefits eligible, and reports to the Pastor.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

COMMUNICATION

- coordinates with the presiders, ministry leads, and employees regarding recruitment, training, scheduling, and ongoing formation of all weekend volunteers to ensure an "irresistible environment."
- Is the contact person for visiting clergy
- orders all supplies needed for worship and sacraments (hosts, wine, candles, linens, etc.)
- at the conclusion of every weekend, evaluates the weekend, addresses concerns, and reports back to the SLT on any issues that need attention

PRESENCE

- Be present before, during, and after all Weekend Masses
- Be present before, during, and after weddings, Confirmation, First Communion, Holy Week & Easter, Christmas, all Holy Days of Obligation, weekday Confessions during Advent & Lent, and Lenten Stations of the Cross

SLT

• is a member of the SLT - Senior Leadership Team - and will attend scheduled meetings and fulfill duties assigned by the team. The Weekend Coordinator will communicate regularly with the Pastor and team members regarding scheduling, planning, and issues of concern.
