DAY 1 SUNDAY AUGUST 27

FLIGHT(S) TO VENICE

We fly from Toronto to Venice. Sit back, relax and enjoy your flight. Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline. Overnight and meals on board

DAY 2 MONDAY AUGUST 28 VENICE-PADUA

Ciao Italia! After clearing customs and immigration, we meet our tour manager Antonella and board our bus to Padua. We check-in at our hotel and enjoy time to rest. Our pilgrimage officially begins with prayers at the Basilica of Saint Anthony and devotion by the tomb of the Saint, followed a Welcome Dinner with all the members of our group.

DAY 3 TUESDAY AUGUST 29

EXCURSION TO VENICE

Today, we take the vaporetto through the Grand Canal to Venice. We'll see Piazza San Marco, the Doge Palace, famous bridges of Venice, pray at St. Mark's Basilica and enjoy a Gondola ride. Enjoy free time for lunch and explore on your own before returning to Padua. Tonight's dinner will include pizza and Bigoli pasta, typical delicacies of this region.

DAY 4 WEDNESDAY AUGUST 30 PADUA-FLORENCE

You may wish to join other pilgrims for early prayers at the Basilica before breakfast. We leave Padua for Florence, the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Arrive and get settled in your hotel. You'll have the afternoon free to stroll and explore on your own. Later tonight, join us to taste the famous "Bistecca alla Fiorentina" (steak Florentine style), one of the glories of Tuscan cuisine.

DAY 6 FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 1

FLORENCE-PISA-LA SPEZIA

We continue our tour and travel to Pisa to see it's Piazza dei Miracoli and the world-famous leaning tower. Continue to La Spezia, gateway of the Cinque Terre, which literally translates to "five earths," a cluster of towns perched on the dramatic cliffs of the Mediterranean coast. We arrive and check-in at our hotel.

DAY 7 SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 2 **CINQUE TERRE** Travel by train and boat and discover the villages and beautiful coastline with its rugged cliffs, turquoise water, and colorful fishing villages. From Monterosso's

lively markets to Vernazza's medieval forts and Manarola's pastel-colored buildings, there is something for everyone to discover and enjoy in Cinque Terre.

DAY 8 SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 3 TUSCAN COUNTRYSIDE-SAN GIMIGNANO-ASSISI

We depart La Spezia and drive towards the heart of Tuscany and the Chianti region to San Gimignano, one of the most charming and picturesque hill towns in Tuscany. There will be free time to wander through the narrow streets, climb the "Torre Grossa" and take pictures of the gorgeous landscape. We visit a local winery and enjoy a wine tasting and lunch. Continue to Assisi, the town of St. Francis and St. Clare. Assisi is a spiritual treasure and one of the most peaceful spots in Italy. We arrive at our hotel, get settled and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner is on your own.

DAY 9 MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 4

Assisi

Morning prayers at the Basilica of St. Francis, which contains many of the possessions of St. Francis and a series of frescoes depicting his life. You will have a chance to see where St. Francis knelt before the crucifix and heard Jesus ask him to rebuild His church. We will also visit the Basilica of St. Clare and pray before the Holy Crucifix from which God spoke to Francis. We'll enjoy the panoramic views of the Italian countryside at a local family-run farm and taste a delicious lunch. Free afternoon and dinner on your own.

DAY 10 TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 5

Assisi-Rome

Morning prayers at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, where we see the "Porziuncola", and continue towards Rome for the last leg of our pilgrimage. We arrive and get settled in our hotel. In the afternoon, we'll enjoy a panoramic sightseeing of Rome. Stop at the Colosseum (outside view) for a picture opportunity, and take a leisurely walk through the historic center of Rome to see the Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps ending at Piazza Navona with dinner at one of its trendy restaurants.

DAY 11 WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 6

PAPAL AUDIENCE & VATICAN CITY

Today is a very emotional day. We arrive at St. Peter's Square to participate in the Papal Audience and to be blessed by the Holy Father (providing His Holiness is in residence). There will be some free time to shop for religious souvenirs and lunch on your own. Next, we visit the Vatican Museum and the incomparable Sistine Chapel, ending our visit at St. Peter's Basilica. Built on the site where St. Peter was martyred, is the largest church in Christendom. A visit to St. Peter's Basilica is awe-inspiring, breathtaking, and will leave you speechless. Dinner on your own. Overnight: Rome

DAY 12 THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 7

This morning, we get to learn the stories and legends of early Christianity, visiting three of the major basilicas: St. John Lateran, the oldest Basilica in Rome, and the official seat of the Pope. Across from it, we visit the Holy Stairs, regarded as the stairs climbed by Jesus on his way to face Pontius Pilate. Next, the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, believed to be the burial ground of St. Paul and finally the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the oldest shrines dedicated to the Blessed Virgin. The afternoon is at leisure. Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant in one of the most iconic neighborhoods in Rome, Trastevere.
