ITINERARY

DAY 1 WED, NOV 5

FLIGHT TO LISBON

We will fly from Toronto to Lisbon aboard Air Canada. Relax and enjoy your flight with complimentary meals and entertainment on board. Group seating for our flight will be assigned by the airline.

DAY 2 THUR. NOV 6

FATIMA

Welcome to Portugal! Upon arrival, meet our local English-speaking tour manager who will escort us to Fátima, where the Blessed Mother appeared in 1917 to three simple shepherd children and exhorted mankind to pray for world peace. While on the way, we will stop in the town of **Santarem** to venerate the **13th-century Eucharistic Miracle** at St. Stephens Church. We check-in at our hotel and have time to rest. We meet Fr. Shawn and Fr. Justin to celebrate mass at the Little Chapel of the Apparitions and enjoy dinner at the hotel. You may want to join the Rosary and Candelight Procession after dinner. Overnight at your hotel in Fatima. (D)

DAY 3 FRI. NOV 7

FATIMA

Following breakfast, we follow the Stations of the Cross, visit Valinhos, and pray at the site where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. To Aljustrel, where the children's hamlet is still preserved in its original state. Back in Fatima, we visit the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia at the Basilica of the Rosary and enjoy free time for private prayers and devotion. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Fatima. Join us tonight for the Rosary and Candlelight Procession after dinner. (B,D)

DAY 4 SAT. NOV 8

FATIMA - LOURDES

Morning mass and free time for further devotion or shopping. We travel to the airport for our flight to Toulouse, France. We arrive and continue by bus to Lourdes, the birthplace of St. Bernadette, to whom Our Lady appeared near the Grotto of Massabielle 18 times between February 11 to July 16, 1858. We check-in at our hotel for a three-night stay. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 5 & 6 Sun & Mon. Nov 9 & 10

LOURDES

During our stay in Lourdes, you will be able to pray at the Grotto and walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette. Visit the Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, attend mass, pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous spring and visit the healing baths. Confession and Adoration are available throughout the day. Praying of the rosary is available in the afternoon and after dinner. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. (B,D)

DAY 7 TUE, NOV 11

LOURDES - ROME

We say goodbye to our Lady of Lourdes and fly to **Rome**. Here, we'll join the multitudes of pilgrims who have been traveling to Rome for centuries for the chance to receive plenary indulgence. We visit the monumental Trevi Fountain and fulfill the tradition of throwing coins into the fountain to ensure a return to Rome. We check-in at our hotel for a three-night stay. This evening, we'll enjoy dinner with Roman specialties at a local restaurant. Overnight at your hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 8 WED, NOV 12

ROME

Enjoy a free morning or join us at at St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience and receive a Blessing by the Holy Father (provided His Holiness is in residence). In the afternoon, we step inside the Colosseum for a guided tour. While the Colosseum is generally known as a historical and tourist site, it also holds great spiritual importance for Catholics. It is here that many Christians were martyred during the persecutions of the Roman Empire. We visit Il Gesu, the Jesuit Mother Church and the headquarters chosen by St. Ignatius shortly after he founded the Society of Jesus in 1540. Celebrate mass and return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B,D)

DAY9 THU, NOV 13

After breakfast, enjoy a tour of Rome visiting the major Basilicas: St. John the Lateran, (the oldest Basilica in Rome and the official ecclesiastical seat of the Pope), St. Paul Outside the Walls - is the second largest after St. Peter's Basilica and it was founded on the burial ground of St. Paul and the St. Mary Major, one of the oldest shrines dedicated to the Blessed Virgin, which contains a relic from the manger of the infant Jesus. We also visit the Holy Stairs (regarded as the stairs climbed by Jesus on his way to face Pontius Pilate) and the Chiesa Nuova - principal church of the Oratorians, built for St. Phillip Neri. Dinner on your own. (B)

DAY 10 FRI, NOV 14

ROME-ASSISI

This morning we visit the remarkable **Sistine Chapel** and **St. Peter's Basilica**. St. Peter's is a masterpiece in itself and was built on the site where St. Peter was martyred. We also visit the excavations below the basilica and the actual tomb of St. Peter. Note: in the event that the underground tour will not be possible, it will be replaced by the Catacombs of St. Calixtus. In the afternoon, we journey to the tiny Umbrian town of Assisi. We arrive and check-in into our hotel for a twonight stay. Dinner at the hotel. (B,D)

DAY 11 SAT, NOV 15

Start the morning at the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi and have the opportunity to pray in the crypt by the saint's remains. Continue to the Basilica of St Clare, visit the crypt which contains the mortal remains of St. Clare and pray at the Chapel of the Crucifix with the famous Byzantine crucifix (12th-century), which, according to the tradition, is supposed to have spoken to St Francis in the church of St Damian. Today, we'll enjoy lunch at a local farmhouse to discover dishes and flavours that make this part of central Italy a gastronome's paradise. Back in town, we visit the **Church of St. Mary Major**, one of the oldest churches in Assisi, and **tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis**. He will be canonized April 27, 2025, then known as Saint Carlo Acutis. Free time to explore the Old Town of Assisi, its wonderful architecture, hillside views as well as soaking in its unique atmosphere. Dinner on your own. (B,L)

DAY 12 SUN, NOV 16

We visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels for final prayers and celebrate mass at the Porziuncola. It is here that St. Francis lived for many years, founded the Franciscan order and died in 1226. We depart en route to Rome for our last evening of the pilgrimage. Tonight, we celebrate a **Farewell Dinner** at a local restaurant. (**B**,**D**)

DAY 13 MON. NOV 17

FLIGHT TO TORONTO Our pilgrimage has come to an end. We depart for the airport and fly to Toronto on Air Canada. CONCLUSION OF OUR PILGRIMAGE. (B)
