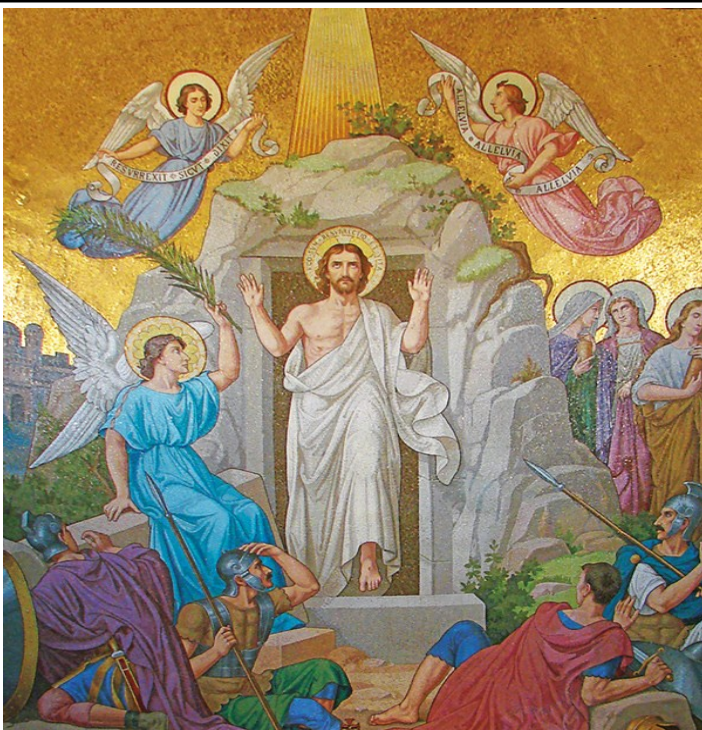

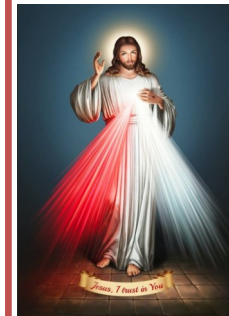
An Easter Message form Fr. Bill...

Divine Mercy Sunday- April 12th @ 3:00 pm



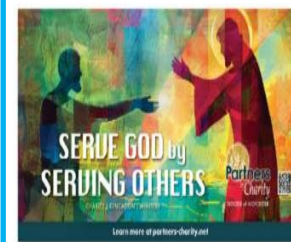

If you have not returned your Visitation House Baby Bottle, please bring it to the church or to the parish office ASAP. Thank you to all who supported this Lenten Charity!

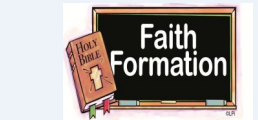
