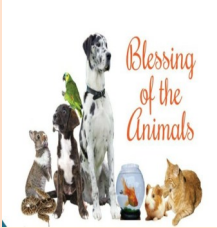




Patronal Feast

This devotion stems from the Battle of Lepanto in 1571, when Pope Saint Pius V attributed a victory to the Virgin Mary after a call to prayer, leading to the establishment of the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7th.
Families can participate by praying the Rosary together, which serves as a meditative and communal prayer focused on the mysteries of Jesus's life.
