

Saint of the Week

Saints Peter and Paul; feast day June 29
Both apostles who died as martyrs at Rome under Nero, between 64-67. This pre-eminent feast day of the city of Rome has been observed on this date since the mid-third century. It commemorates the martyrdoms of Peter the "chief of the apostles" and Paul the "apostle of the Gentiles" Noted for their faith, their courage, and their leadership during the difficult days of the birth of the Church.
