Growth in Ordinary Time

Today, we begin celebrating the Sunday liturgies of Ordinary Time. We have been celebrating some lofty solemnities, Corpus Christi, Trinity Sunday, Pentecost, Ascension. Now, we shift to the Sundays of Ordinary Time. Ordinary in this sense does not mean "commonplace" or "mundane." Ordinary comes from the word ordinal, which means to be numbered. These numbered weeks of ordinary time, then, are not ordinary or mundane, but this season is a season of growth. The liturgical color is green, symbolic of that growth and the theological virtue of hope. We often put a lot of work in preparing ourselves through the seasons of Lent, and sometimes Advent. Perhaps we can take these weeks of Ordinary Time and commit or renew a commitment to some spiritual practice – perhaps reading Scripture, praying the rosary, or making a habit of going to Reconciliation regularly. In today's Gospel, Jesus points to the growth of seeds growing secretly and very naturally to show the growth of the kingdom of God. I think we have seen this in the history of the Church, and I hope that we can see it in our lives as well. I pray that whatever way you decide to observe or celebrate during this season of Ordinary Time, you will find that the seed you plant will sprout, and grow, and bear fruit that will last.
