#### "Talitha koum!"

The above words are the words of Jesus to the synagogue official, Jairus', daughter. They mean, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" With these words spoken, the little girl, whom everyone thought was dead, comes to life. St. Mark tells us, that she "arose immediately and walked around." Jesus speaks generative words, offering life to the dead. The words written in Scripture, are the original Aramaic, the words are presented in the middle of the Gospel, which is written in Greek, as Jesus would have said them. The beauty and the power of the words are displayed in the text. And they could have an opportunity to be displayed in our minds and hearts today as we hear these words proclaimed, and allow them to take on their full meaning in our lives. All of Jesus' miracles, show us what is to come. He brings redemption, forgiveness of sins, and the offering of this invitation to eternal life – life with Him forever. Jesus is the New Adam, the first born of creation, and what was lost in sin, is now repaired. He brings the dead to life, much like He has done with the synagogue official's daughter. From there, she has the power to get up and walk around – to live out that gift which is given to her. Today, may we hear these creative words that are spoken to us, and take heart in living them out.
