Mass Intentions Book Open for 2023

- This year, we received more Mass intentions than could be accommodated during the current calendar year, so the excess of intentions have already been scheduled in early 2023.
- In order to avoid overbooking in 2023, and in order to ensure that all have the opportunity to have Masses said for their intentions, we are currently accepting <u>no more than two</u> <u>intentions per family</u>. A bulletin notice will inform you in the New Year if any dates remain open, and if thus we are able to accept any additional intentions.
- Specific dates may be requested; however, it is not always possible to accommodate such requests. It is not possible to reserve multiple Sundays.
- The recommended offering per Mass intention is \$10. It is presumed that someone who requests a Mass is willing and able to make the offering, so no Mass requests are confirmed until the offering has been received. In case of difficulty, please contact the parish office.
- Cash or check are accepted. There is no online form for submitting Mass intentions. Written requests with the accompanying donation – submitted by mail or dropped into the collection basket on Sunday – are the preferred method. Email requests are tolerated, but the donation must be submitted before requests are confirmed. We do not take intentions via telephone.
