Q: What is the Edge Program?

A: Edge is a middle school youth ministry experience created for early adolescents in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade. Edge is open to ALL middle school students and their friends regardless of religion, denomination, or faith, and is designed to meet the spiritual, emotional, and social needs of the youth through meaningful experiences.

Q: What do you do at Edge?

A: During the school year the last Monday of every month is an Edge Night where the youth gather for food, fun, and fellowship, as well as discuss various topics. Also, throughout the year Edge coordinates various service projects, spiritual retreats, and community events to bring the youth closer to God and deepen their Catholic faith.
