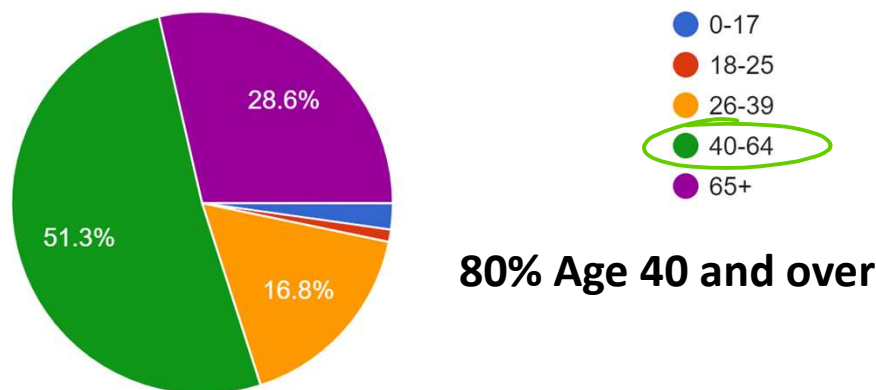

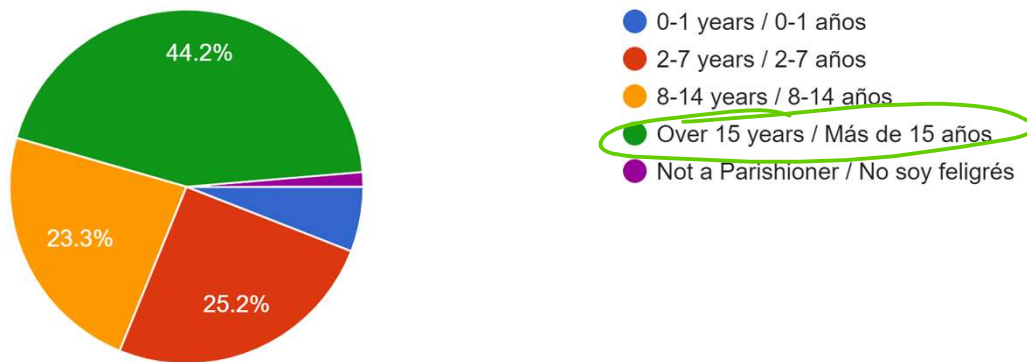

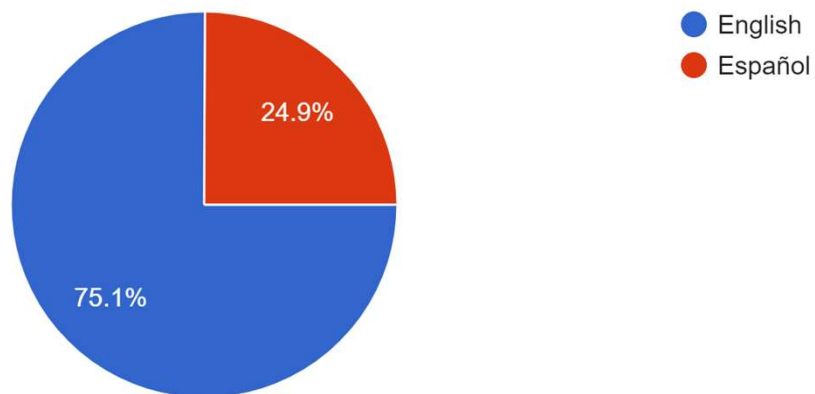
## What is your age group?



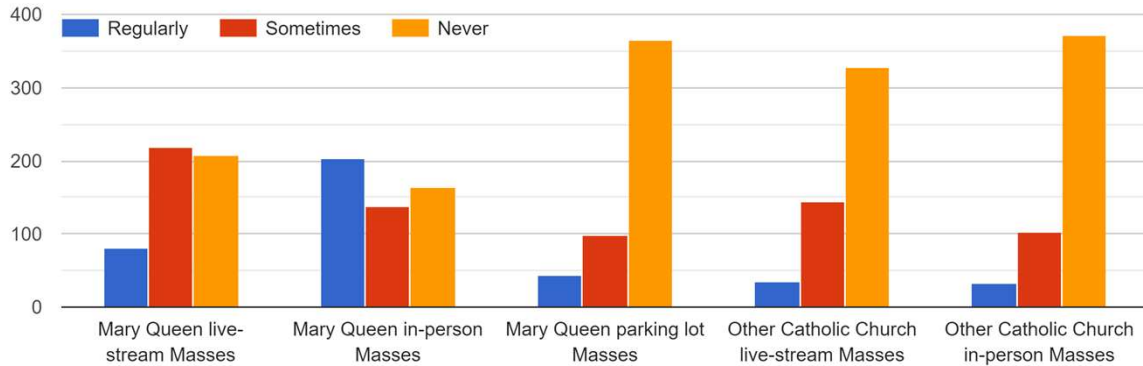
## How long have you been a parishioner?



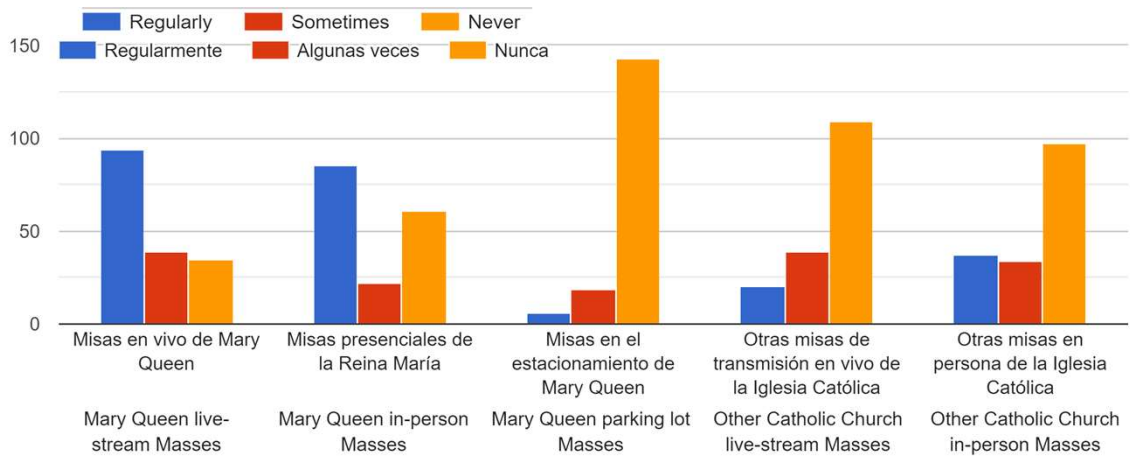
## Preferred language?



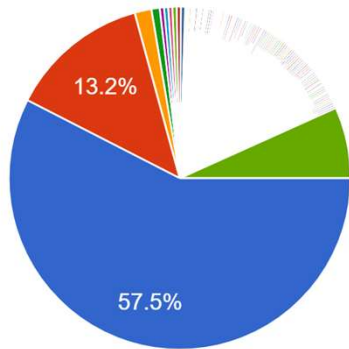
## English Mass Attendance Last 30 Days



## Spanish Mass Attendance Last 30 Days



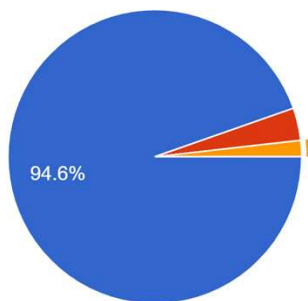
## How will no masks impact your Mass attendance? (English Masses)

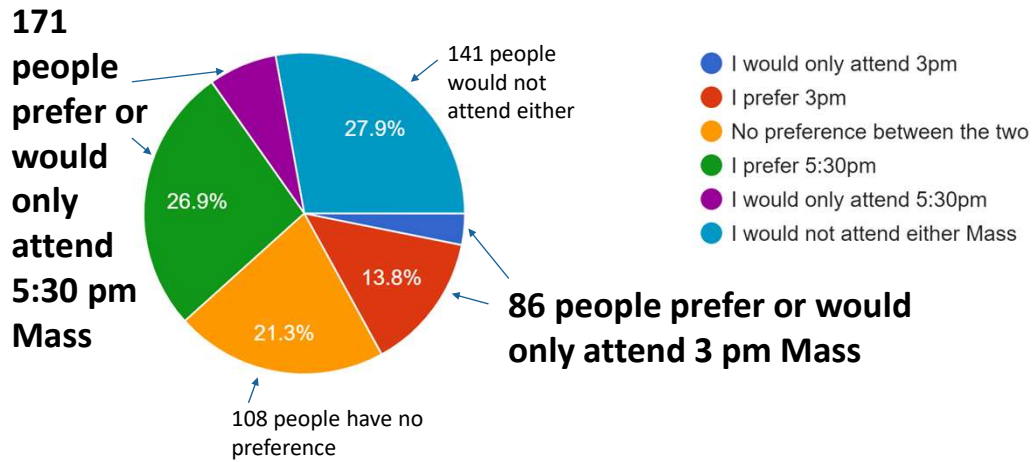
## How will no masks impact your Mass attendance? (Spanish Masses)

## NET PROMOTER SCORE (NPS)

---

**75%** - **9%** = **66 NPS** (Total Parish)

**69%** - **12%** = **57 NPS** (English Only)

**94%** - **1%** = **93 NPS** (Spanish Only)

### *Reasons why respondents chose 6 or below...*

---

- 17 – Liberal, Mainstream Media Dominance, Homilies too political
- 6 – Too much Spanish, too focused on immigration
- 5 – Don't feel at home, cliquish, hard to fit in
- 4 – Complaints about Bishop, Socialist and Marxist Views
- 4 – Not traditional Mass, Church decorated Protestant, Music too contemporary
- 4 – Covid restrictions at school and church too rigorous

### *Reasons why respondents chose 7 or 8...*

---

- 14 – People, Priests, Fellowship all good
- 11 – Too liberal/political, sermons not relatable
- 10 – Open to marginalized, welcoming, spiritual growth
- 4 – Music is good
- 3 – Too much bilingual
- 4 – Covid restrictions too strict, Covid concerns
- 2 – Don't fit in

## *Reasons why respondents chose 9 or 10...*

---

202 – Community, Welcoming, Home, Family, Caring and Friendly Parishioners

62 – Great Priests and Deacons, Excellent preaching, Great Leadership, Listen, Fr. Dan (24)

77 – Best church, love for Mary Queen, Catholic Church, Faith

21 – Many ministries, volunteer opportunities, social justice, ACTS, RCIA, Adult Education

13 – Diversity, Inclusive, English and Spanish

11 – Great school, Catholic education

16 – Handling of Pandemic, feel safe

13 – Mass, Sacraments, Prayer, Music

4 – Great communication and technology

## BIGGEST NEEDS

---

163 – Nothing/No Need (84 – English and 79 – Spanish)

112 – Fellowship, Community, Reconnect, Return of ministries, Meet new friends, Smiling faces

111 – Mass in person, Communion, Worship together, Sacraments, Confession

73 – Prayer, Eucharistic Adoration, Jesus, patience, world peace, hope, holiness (32 Eng. & 41 Sp.)

65 – Safe environment for everyone, to be safe and feel safe

35 – Financial stability, job, health/healing, home projects, financial aid, time

28 – More Mass options, Mass time preferences (parking lot, 5:30 pm, live streaming)

18 – Hear more messages from Scripture, less political, encourage spiritual growth

13 – Kids section during Mass, Children's Liturgy, Sunday School options, youth/teen activities

12 – Improve Mass experience

2 – Better communication    2 – Church needs to adapt to times    1 – Thank you to Fr. Dan & staff

## FUTURE SUGGESTIONS

---

- 61 – Continue being Covid Cautious (*5 prefer Mass attendance lower, 5 keep social distancing, 12 Spanish – keep masks*)
- 43 – More social activities (big & small)
- 38 – Return to normal
- 32 – Continue live streaming Masses
- 27 – More small groups, Bible Studies/Emphasis on Word of God, more Catechesis, in person Formation
- 17 – Normal seating/dismissal, bring Holy Water back
- 11 – No hand holding/contact during Mass
- 11 – Keep virtual meetings
- 11 – Keep up/do more cleaning
- 10 – No common cup/ alternative ways for Precious Blood

## FUTURE SUGGESTIONS

---

- 10 – in person meetings
- 10 – More communal prayer and increase access to Adoration
- 8 – Build Community/Unity between English and Spanish
- 7 – Less political/liberal
- 6 – Single language Masses only
- 6 – More youth/young adult emphasis
- 6 – More singing/engaging singing
- 6 – More community service
- 6 – Fall Festival
