

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

The United States bishops have begun a Eucharistic Revival to educate Catholics on the real presence of Christ. It began in 2022. It will end in 2024 with a Eucharistic Congress to be held in Indianapolis. The first year is for dioceses to organize, the second year is for parishes to have activities to enrich parishioners, the third year is to send people out on mission.

A revival is meant to heal the affliction and pain of the people. It also is to help the people find joy in giving and being hospitable to others. It breaks the isolation by bringing people together in small groups. This revival is to bring people together through study and understanding of the Eucharist. There is power from Holy Spirit through revival.
