We need one lead teacher and one helper for each session, as well as a helper overseeing open gym activities. *Lead teacher openings:* September 22nd, October 13th, November 10th. - **Sunday morning** – During the 9:15 a.m. – 10:15 a.m. adult and teen Bible study class taught by Pastor Steve in the auditorium, we will have open gym for the younger kids.

Answers to FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

- **Place the brochure so it is leaning against the door. You are not being asked to ring the doorbell, or talk to anyone.**
- **You have from Sunday, September 12th until Thursday, October 7th to make all of your deliveries.**
- **The Redeemer Youth have committed to delivering a significant number of these brochures. Let's all join in and make this a successful blanketing of the neighborhoods.**
- **We are targeting the cities of Wayzata, Plymouth, Long Lake, Orono, Maple Plain, Loretto, Spring Park, Minnetonka Beach, and Tonka Bay.**
- **When you finish your commitment area, you may come back and get more brochures and another area.**
- **Go on days that are good for you. And go often!**
- **It should take about an hour of your time to deliver 30-100 brochures, depending on the neighborhood. So if we want to deliver 30,000 brochures, we are going to need everyone's participation!**

Just as Jesus sent out his disciples two by two, you are encouraged to go out two by two and deliver these brochures to the front steps of the people living around Redeemer inviting them to come, find, and worship Jesus with us.
