There are 2 ways to participate:

1. A monetary donation towards the cost of Thanksgiving dinner for a family.

- Donations of any amount are welcome. \$25 covers the cost of the items traditionally gathered for the baskets and \$12 covers the cost of a turkey.

- Only the driver should be in the vehicle and must wear a mask.
- Drivers are needed to deliver to Assumption in SE Washington and St. Joseph's in Largo.
