Each subsequent month a new family or individual or couple will host. And the participants will rotate so that every time you'll be sharing with a new group of people.

We're looking for folks to come forward and take on the role of being a host on our initial Sunday, February 12. We will provide you with a template of how your evening should run. We look forward to the enthusiastic participation of everyone involved. So, please, come join us for dinner.
