

St. James School Families:

If you have a K-12 student, it is time to apply for Student Tuition Organization (STO) tuition grants for the 2018-2019 school year.

You may be eligible to receive a grant from the STO of Southeast Iowa if your household income from line 22 of IRS Form 1040 (or line 15 of IRS Form 1040A) does not exceed the amount shown below for the number of people in your household.

Dear St. James School Families,

The 2018-19 St. James School Scholarship Application and the STO Application are now available. Every family is invited and encouraged to complete these scholarship applications.

<u>St. James School Scholarships</u> are considered for all applicants that express a need. Financial need is not the only factor considered. Family size, active parish membership, personal circumstances, and volunteerism are all a part of the confidential application process. We are interested in knowing what motivates you to choose St. James School for your child.

School scholarship awards can reach as high as \$1000.00 per student. Last year, we were successful in providing financial support for **EVERY** family that completed an application. If your children are enjoying St. James School, then our goal is to find a financial arrangement that works for you. **Applications are due June 1, 2018**.

**STO Applications** (School Tuition Organization of Southeast Iowa) are **due no later than April 17, 2016**. This application requires that you include a copy of your 2017 Federal Tax Return. Qualifying individuals are K-12 students who live in an Iowa household and whose income falls into the guidelines outlined at <u>www.stoseiowa.org</u>. Based on eligibility, your family may receive an award that covers a majority of your tuition bill. Please consider applying for an STO scholarship, the awards can be amazing!!

#### St. James School is eligible to receive \$60,000.00 in STO funds in 2018-2019 for qualifying families!!!

Please don't let financial concerns stop you from choosing St. James School for your children. If you are committed to having your student attend St. James School, then we are committed to finding a way to make that happen. # 2018-2019 Financial Aid Application

#### **1** Application Instructions

- You must include copies of pages 1 and 2 of your 2017 federal income tax return (Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) with this application. If you were not required to file a tax return for 2017, you must sign the nonfiler affidavit in Section 8 and submit all Forms W-2 or 1099 received by members of your household.
- Submit this application directly to your school's business or financial aid office by April 17, 2018. Only applications received by that date will be considered for funding by the STO of Southeast Iowa. Late applications will be processed only for purposes of determining your qualification for other financial aid.
- Your financial need is determined by reference to your household's size and income. The term "household" refers to all individuals who live in the same dwelling place, regardless of age, legal relationship, or dependency status. Your household may include different people than those in your family.

#### 2 Household Members

- Starting with yourself, list the name and birth date of every person who lived in your home on December 31, 2017.
- Include everyone who lived with you, regardless of relationship, even children in college and those not in school.
