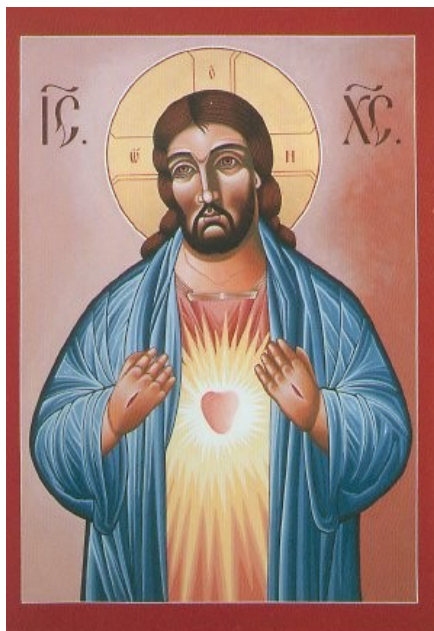

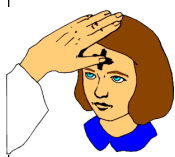
International Mardi Gras Celebration!
