DEACON'S NOTE:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Paul parish has been using a very old software program to manage the parish calendar and the facility utiliza-

tion. The system is not very user friendly, which creates additional work for the office staff, as well as the vendor has stopped supporting the program with updates. Hence, we are moving to a new web-based program to manage the parish calendar and facility utilization. It will take a few weeks before we can load all of the existing data into the database. Once completed, parishioners and visitors can view the calendar in real time. providing current and accurate data that is automatically generated from the program to the parish website. No more manual entries into two different programs by the office staff. In the future parishioners will be able to complete and submit a web-based Facilities Request form off of the parish website based on the availability of a facility shown in the parish calendar. Once implemented this will be a much more efficient and friendlier system and process for everyone. Please be patient with the office staff over the next few weeks as we implement the new system. More detailed information to follow in the next few weeks.


