

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

UPCOMING ALL SAINTS AND ALL SOULS:

The Feast of All Saints is on a SATURDAY this year. We'll have a 4pm Mass at Resn on Fri Oct 31, and then on Sat morn Nov 1 at 8am at St. Paul and a 9am at Resn.

- If you fill out an All Souls envelopes we will put those envelopes on the altar at both St. Paul and Resurrection for all the Masses in November. ALSO, you can write your loved one's name into the BOOK OF LIFE at both St. Paul and Resurrection and we will pray for all those names written into the Book of Life at each parish at all the Masse during the month of November as well (and this is free of charge!) The books will be in the churches starting November 1 and you can fill in names before or after Masses.
- Finally, on Sat Nov 1 at 5pm at St. Paul and Sun Nov 2 at 1130am at Resurrection we will have special "REMEMBRANCE" Masses where we will pray for all those who have died through our parishes BY NAME. Those who were buried through St. Paul at St. Paul and those who were buried through Resurrection at Resurrection. We will also be happy to read the names of any family or friends who have died in the last year who were not part of our pastorate.

THE ARTESANOS OF DON BOSCO are the artists who made the ambo and altar for the renovated new church at Resurrection. The group "Mato Grosso" is a Catholic group which runs 110 mission sites in South America for the poor. They raise money for those missions, in part, by selling art and furniture made by people from their missions. The furniture and art is of the highest quality. They will have their wares displayed and will have people to help you if you are interested in any of their items on the weekends of Nov 1-2 and Nov 8-9 at Church of the Resurrection. All of the funds raised go to Mato Grosso, which, again, is doing great work for those in-need in South America and which also is active in the Baltimore region.

DEACON'S NOTE:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Two weekends ago Dcn. Allen and myself along with our wives had the opportunity to attend the

Archdiocese of Baltimore Deacon Convocation. It was an awesome weekend of fellowship and enrichment with other deacons in the diocese. The weekend provided us the opportunity to revisit our day of ordination. It reminded us that we were ordained to serve, requiring us to give of ourselves sacrificially. As deacons our servanthood is sourced in God. Jesus and His mother Mary are models of the servanthood we are called to undertake. We are called to minister to the poor and needy, not just physically, but also spiritually within our diaconate ministry. When we were ordained to the diaconate each of us took on a new identify. Just like in the sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation, an indelible seal is placed on our souls identifying us as deacons. Yes, we receive the title of deacon, not to set us apart from anyone, but to remind us of our call to servanthood. When we are addressed as deacon it truly is a reminder of the commitment that we made on the day of our ordination, to serve all of God's children.

As members of the clergy we have facilities within the Archdiocese of Baltimore to: Bless people and items, baptize people into the faith, officiate weddings, conduct funerals, perform communion services, serve at Mass, and offer homilies. What we are not are; glorified altar servers or the priest helper. In fact, according to the General Instructions of the Roman Missal (GIRM) the deacon is required to perform the following parts of the Mass; lead the penitential rite, proclaim the Gospel, lead the universal prayers, set the altar for the consecration, mingle the water and wine prior to the consecration, offer the sign of peace, distribute Holy Communion, and dismiss the congregation after the final Blessing.

Both Dcn. Allen and I can attest that our diaconate vocation has changed our lives for the better, serving God's children is a wonderful gift that we have received. The Archdiocese of Baltimore is seeking faithful Catholic men who feel called to serve the Church as permanent deacons. You need to be between the ages of 35 and 55 to apply to the diaconate formation program. Details of informational sessions being conducted by the archdiocese can be found further in the bulletin. If you or someone you know may feel the call to the diaconate please attend one of the sessions. You can also talk to Dcn. Allen or myself.
