**PASTOR'S CORNER:**

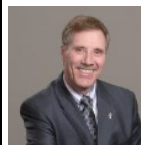
Dear Parishioners,

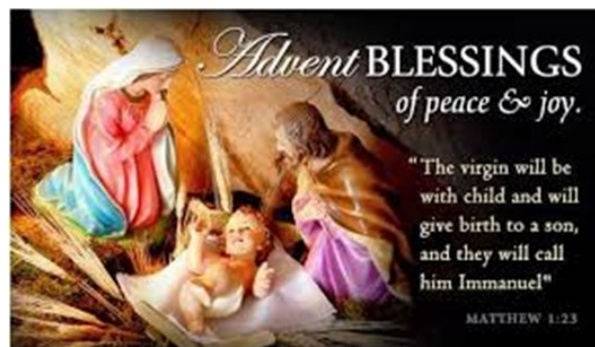
