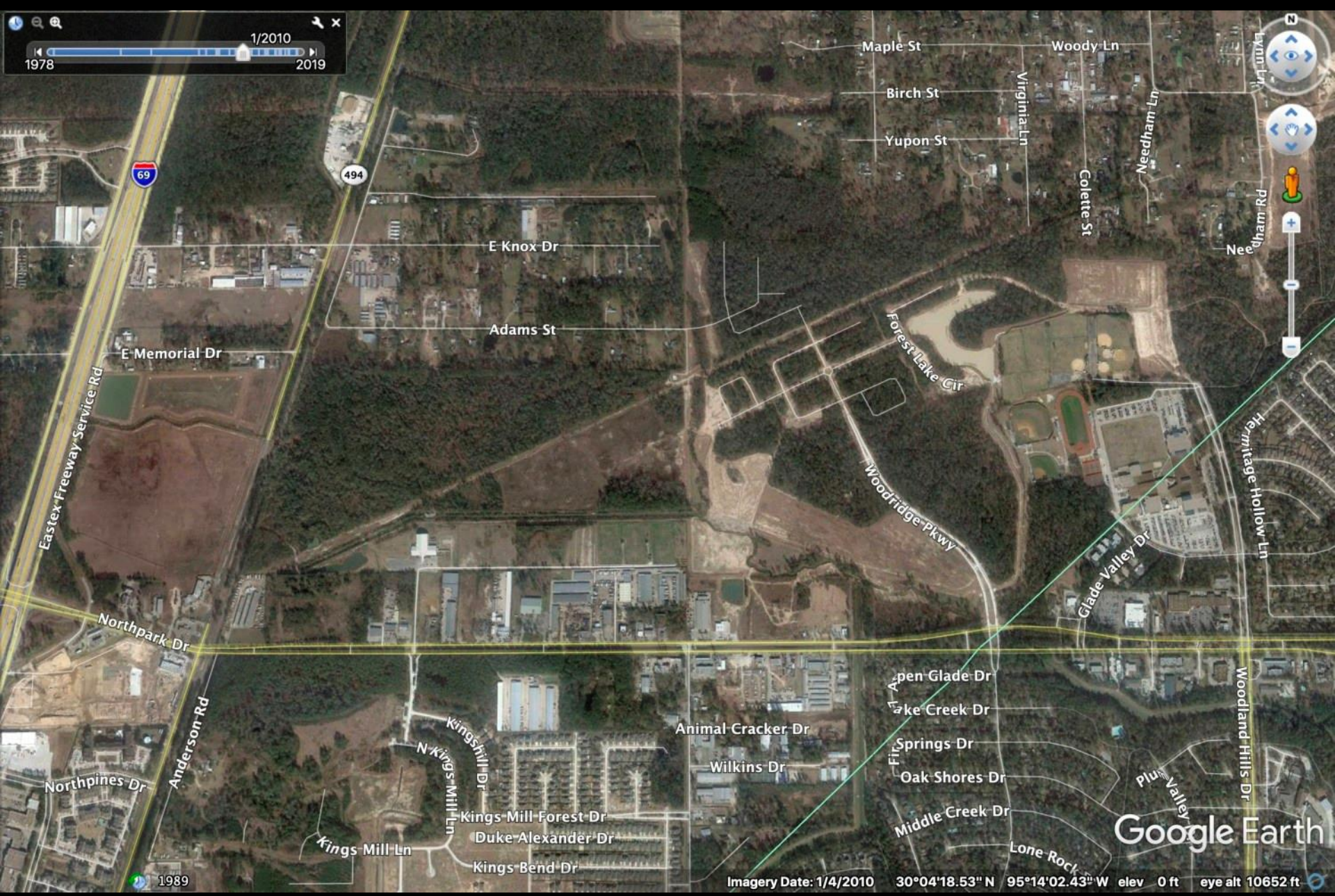

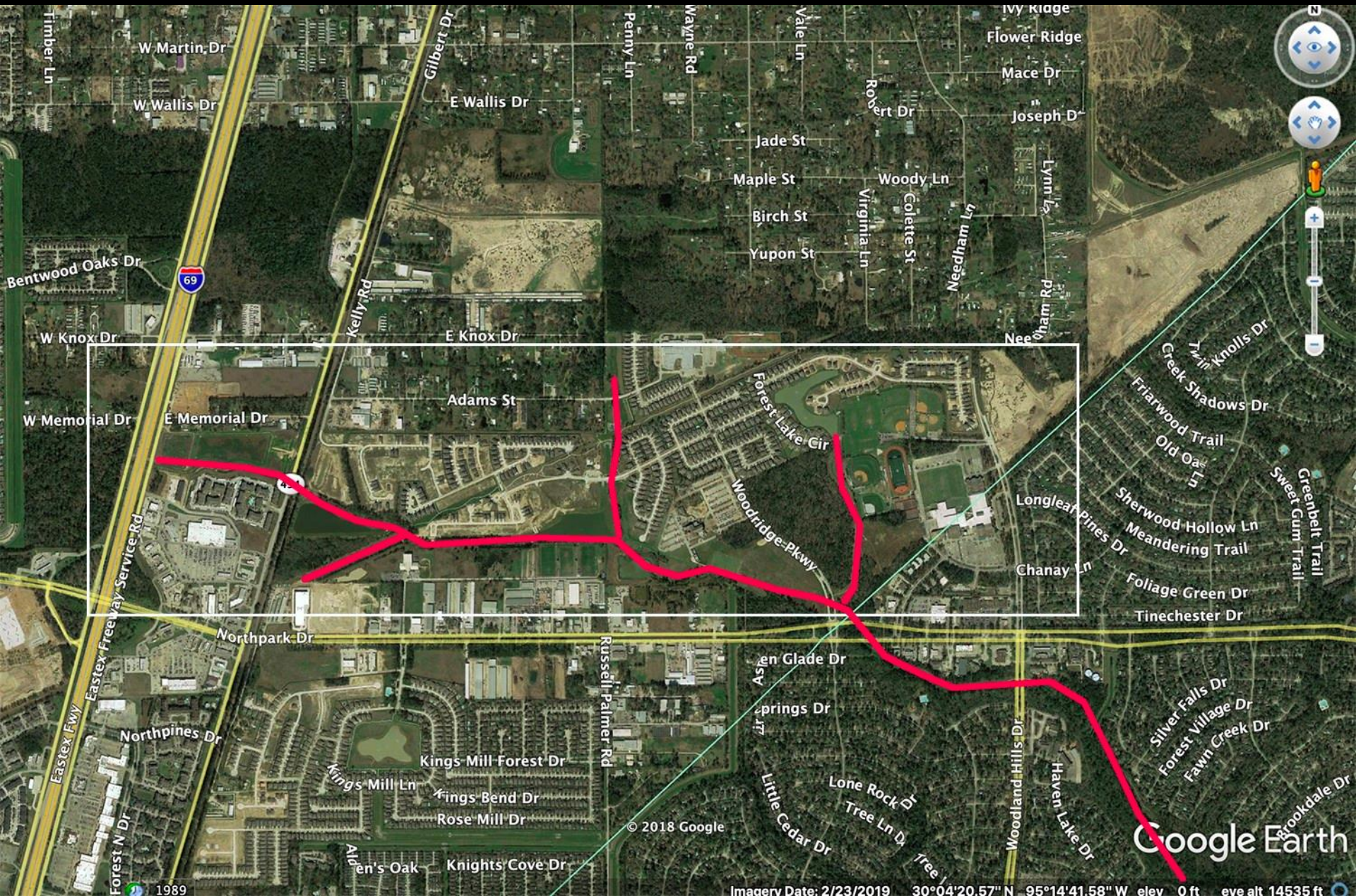

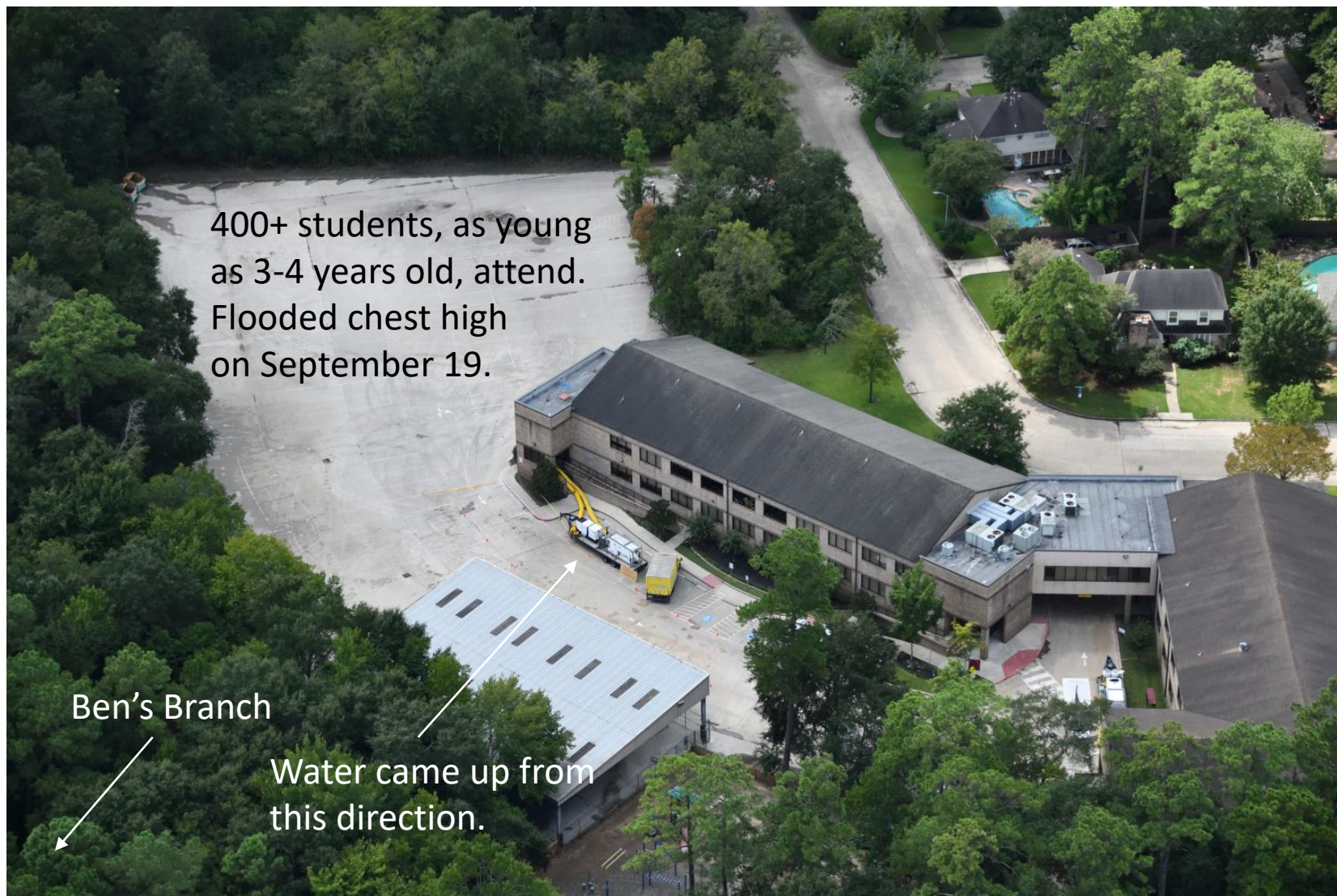
Ben's Branch At Woodland Hills Drive Two Blocks south of Woodridge Village and Kingwood Park High School.

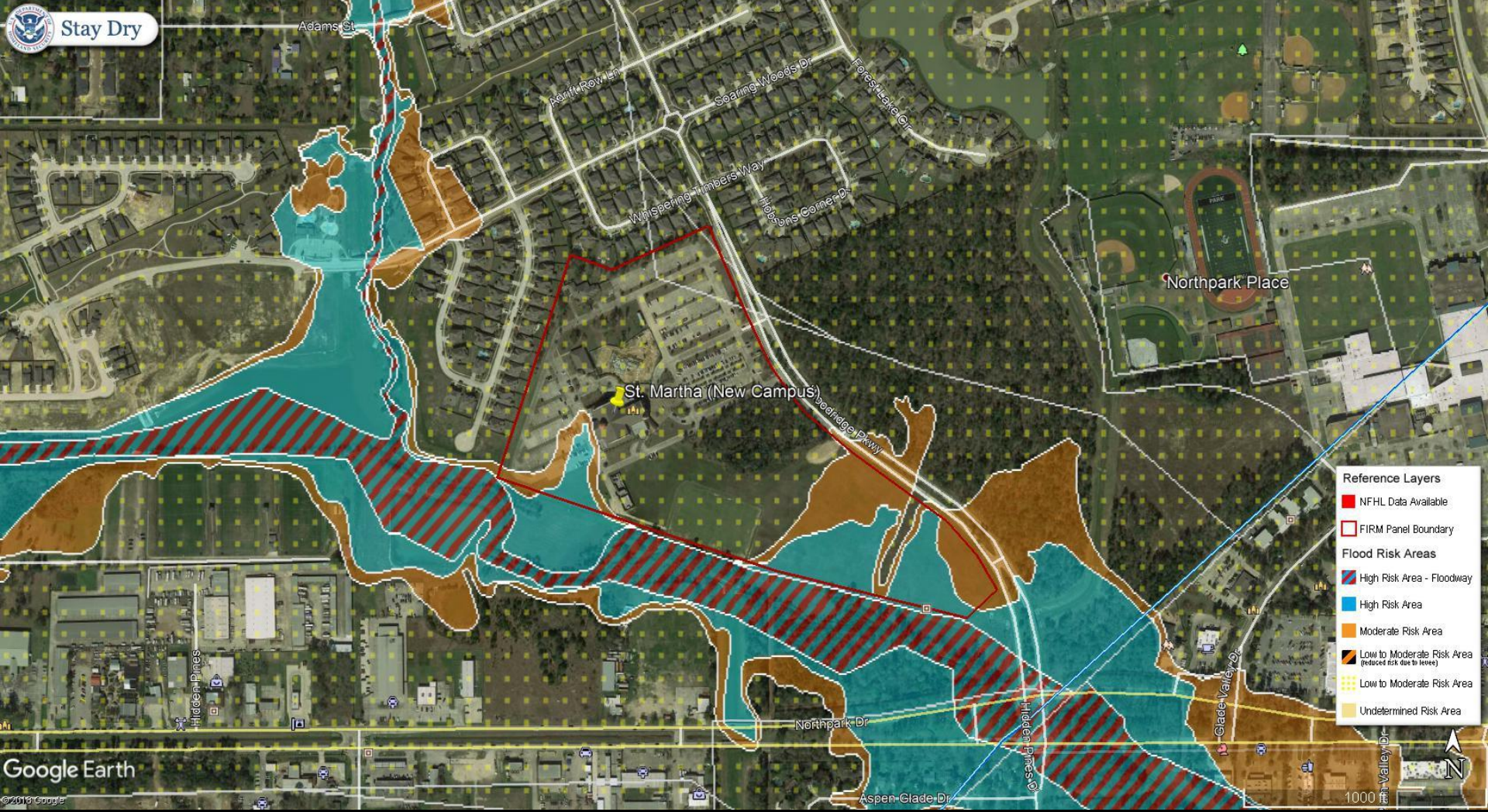
