Guidelines for Attending Mass, effective June 20, 2020

Updates to the Public Celebration of Mass

Dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass continues until further notice.

We will continue to livestream our Mass, and will add the following options beginning June 20th:

- Limited occupancy for public Mass, 5:15pm Saturday and 10:00am Sunday
- After watching the 8am livestream Mass on your personal device in our parking lot, parishioners are invited to enter the Gathering Space through the main, center doors to receive Communion at approximately 9am Sunday.

We care deeply for our parishioners, and cannot offer a 100% safe option to attend Mass. Persons over 65 or with preexisting conditions are strongly encouraged to not attend a public celebration of the Mass.

Livestream Mass will continue on the Pax Christi YouTube channel, Sunday - Thursday at 8am.

Registration to attend the public Mass is required; an invitation to register will be emailed to parishioners on June 16. Public Mass times will be Saturday 5:15pm, Sunday 10am.

Please call our office if you do not have internet or access to email.

Registration is not required to watch the 8am Livestream Mass on your personal device in our parking lot, and then enter the Gathering Space through the main, center doors to receive Communion at approximately 9am Sunday.

All those in attendance are asked to wear a mask at all times, we will have a limited number of disposable masks.

Everyone is asked to practice social distancing and use hand sanitizer.

Use the provided hand sanitizer upon entering the church and before Communion.

Arrive 20 minutes early, enter through the main double glass doors and exit as directed by the ushers.

Please listen to instructions and we thank you for your patience and understanding.
