Autumn Lake Healthcare at Pikesville (our neighbor on Sudbrook Ln.)

A gift to remember an elderly man or woman at Christmas.

- Body wash – for men and ladies
- Bottles of lotion, Boxes of tissue, Bags of individually wrapped hard candy
- Warm bed throws (60x70)
- Coloring books – preferably simple designs like flowers and animals, thick crayons and markers
- Adult Coloring books with thin pencils/pens/markers
- Word Search books (large print)--Simple craft kits--Any kind of yarn for knitting (leftovers fine)

Pregnancy Center West / Women's Center West (in Catonsville)

Baby needs, layette items, diapers and money to support mothers with troubled pregnancies who choose life for their babies.

- \$25 checks (any amount welcome) payable to PCW – used to purchase new car seats, pack and play portable cribs, and to support the sonogram program
- Baby bath products – wash/shampoo, lotion, cornstarch powder, hooded towels & washcloths
- Diapers – sizes most needed are 1, 2, 3, and 4
- Diaper wipes and ointment (e.g. Desitin)
- Baby clothes - size newborn to 12 months – onesies (white preferred), sleepers, outfits, socks
- Sheets for pack and play portable crib or standard cribs
- Receiving blankets (available in packs of 4 or more)
