
Dear St. Thomas More Community,

A wig with synthetic hair is quite itchy, and can add more discomfort to the life of a child struggling to beat cancer. Wigs made with real hair can cost over \$1000.

Participating individuals will give up "cutting their hair" for Lent. Your daughter simply needs to 1. Commit to cutting her hair (with attached permission slip) 2. Get her hair cut at a salon of her choice during Holy Week 3. Take before and after pictures to be included in school news and posts, and 4. Bring her hair to school to be blessed. We will let you know the mass the hair will be blessed at so that you may stream it.
