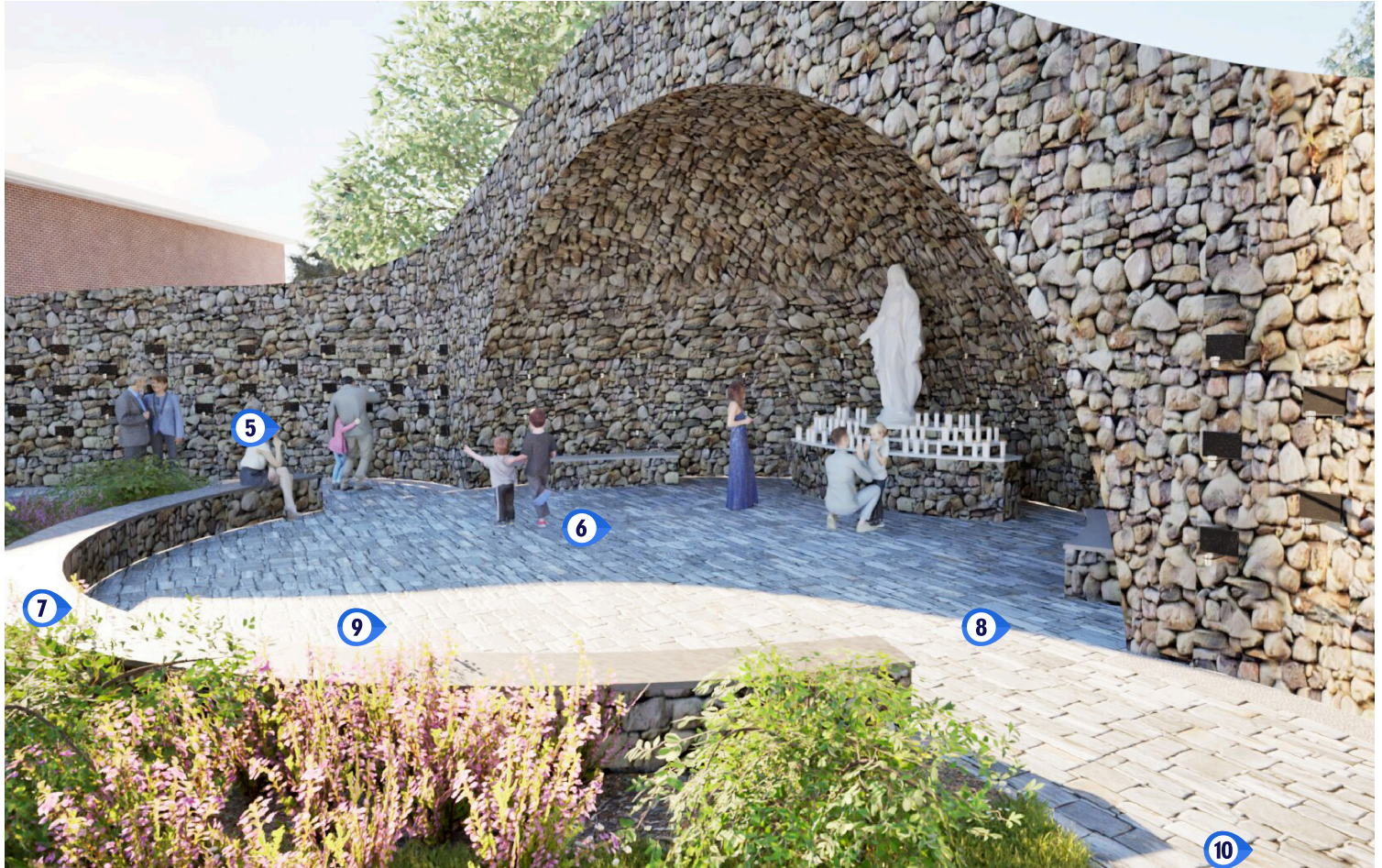

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is the time frame for the project?

Construction is expected to begin in May and will be completed in September/October.
Donations will be accepted in perpetuity.

2. How do I submit the engraving information for my item?

- If you purchased a paver, brick, or a memorial wall plaque, you will receive a confirmation email with a fillable PDF that includes instructions for submitting your names.
- Engraving is limited to three lines with up to twenty characters per line. Spaces and punctuation are considered characters.

3. Can I choose the placement of my brick or wall plaque?

No, placement cannot be requested. It will be determined by the designer.

4. Will the bench have individual memorial plaques on the two-foot section?

No, the bench will have one plaque at the end for the memorial names.

5. Which items have limited quantities?

- There are 6 stone candle slab sections (Item #6)
- There are 12 stone bench sections (Item #7).
