

To help meet the needs of our Community:

- We will celebrate a 4:00 pm Mass on Saturday in the Church (and upload it to Youtube).
- We will also celebrate a 9:00 and 11:00 am Mass on Sunday. These will be outdoor Masses held on the large grass area on the East side of the church. Kindly bring your lawn chairs or a blanket. No chairs will be provided.

In order to be responsible citizens and to respecting all human life we will need to follow the recommendations of the Public Health Department.

1. Our Church is limited by its ability to maintain social distancing. Thus we are using an outdoor space on Sunday Morning to ensure social distancing can be maintained.
2. If you or any member of your household is sick with flu-like symptoms please stay home and get tested.
3. If you are supposed to be in quarantine please respect those guidelines and remain home.
4. It is recommended that you take your temperature if possible before coming to ensure it is normal.
5. There will be limited access to the washrooms. Please ensure "everyone" uses the facilities before leaving home. Mass will be about 40 minutes long.
6. It is recommended to wear a mask for your health and the health of others. We ask people to bring their own masks.
7. Upon entering or arriving, everyone is to use hand sanitizer. It will be onsite.
8. A household consists of everyone living at the same address.
9. Different households are required to social distance by remaining 6ft / 2 metres apart.
10. Members of the same household do not need to social distance from each other.
11. You MUST sign up in order to attend Mass. This is to ensure that we have a list of all attendees in case further action is needed as per Public Health requirements.
12. The 4:00 pm Saturday Mass will allow 20 or so people to attend. This Mass is restricted to seniors or others with mobility issues. The Mass sign up tool must be used to register regardless.
13. Please bring your own seating to the outdoor 9:00 and 11:00 am Sunday Masses.
14. Families will be required to remain in their household bubble in order to social distance from other families. It is essential that children remain with their family members and not associate with others during Mass.
15. The above conditions must be adhered to so that we can continue to celebrate the Mass as a community.

We cannot overlook the reasons for being cautious in our approach. We need all of our members to remain healthy in mind, body and spirit, during this most unusual time in our lives.
