Please continue to pray for those whom are still in the hospital, after the August 3rd tragedy.

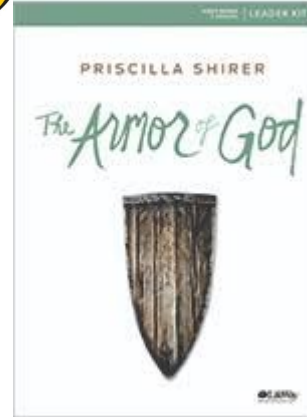
Keep **D'aun Lucero** on your prayer list as she underwent surgery on Thursday.
