Do you want to earn more game cards? Here's how!

Earn these Prayer Cards by memorizing the prayers and reciting them to your catechist or to Mrs. Cathcart:

1. Hail Mary
2. Mealtime prayer
3. Guardian angel prayer
4. Glory Be
5. Apostles' Creed
6. Our Father

Earn these Prayer Cards by trying this type of prayer and telling your catechist or Mrs. Cathcart about it:

1. Rosary
2. Birthday prayer
3. Bedtime prayer
4. Nature prayer
5. Mass

Earn these Life in the Church Cards by participating in the Life of the Church in this way and then telling Mrs. Cathcart or your catechist about it:

1. Bring food to food collection Sunday (the first Sunday of the month)
2. Go to coffee and donuts
3. Give to the collection basket
4. Go to Mass on Ash Wednesday
5. Go to Children's Liturgy of the Word
6. Go to Stations of the Cross
7. Go to Reconciliation (or, if you're too young to go to Reconciliation, pray for forgiveness when you've done something wrong)
8. Make an Advent Wreath
9. Attend a baptism
