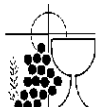

Confessions at ICC

We will begin offering confessions again at ICC 30 minutes before each weekend Mass starting in July, that is for both Saturday and Sunday Masses

First Saturday – July 3

There will be a First Saturday Mass on July 3 at Immaculate Conception. Mass at 9am, followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and confessions from 9:30-10:30am ending with Benediction.

RCIA

In the fall, we will begin RCIA again, the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. RCIA is the yearly program for any adults (and sometimes teenagers) who want to become Catholic, or perhaps learn about the Catholic faith. Then at Easter, they are received into the Catholic Church. There is no obligation for anyone in RCIA to become Catholic, however. This is the time to invite your non-Catholic friends, family, spouses to come to Mass with you or simply to ask them if they would want to become Catholic. That way, by the time we begin announcing for people to sign up for RCIA, they might be ready.

In today's Gospel, Jesus takes a young girl's hand, instructs her to "arise," and then tells her parents to give her something to eat. He saves her from death and ensures that she is fed, and He does the same for us today. Jesus saves us from sin and death, invites us into a relationship with Him, and nourishes us with His Real Presence in the Eucharist! Alleluia! May we respond in faith to this invitation, take hold of His outstretched hand, and journey with our Lord into the future with faith, hope, love, and courage.
