October 10 - Departure to Turkey

Depart on flight TK10 at 06:35pm.

October 11 - Arrive in Istanbul

Arrive at 5:35pm and meet our guide and bus driver. Dinner and overnight.

October 12 - Full-day Istanbul

After breakfast, we will stroll through Hippodrome Square. Afterward, we are off to witness the incredible majesty and splendor of the Sultan Ahmet Mosque. Then, we will walk to visit the domed masterpiece of the Hagia Sophia. Then, we head to Topkapi Palace, located on the very cape of the peninsula where Constantinople was founded. Then, we will end our day with an evening of shopping at the Grand Bazaar. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

October 13 - Full day tour + transfer Istanbul Airport & Kayseri Apt, Cappadocia

We will begin our day by shopping at Eminönü's Spice Bazaar. Then, we will embark on a cruise of the Bosphorus with its views of the old wooden mansions, Ottoman palaces, and ancient fortresses that dot the river's coast. Afterward, Explore the former fishing village Ortakoy which sits on the Bosphorus. Here we will enjoy the famous Turkish street food kumpir (loaded baked potato) and the many quaint cafés, idyllic views, and the beautiful neo-Baroque mosque that sits by the river. Then, we will drive to Istanbul Airport, fly to Kayseri by TK

2014 at 4:00 PM, and arrive in Kayseri at 05:35 PM—dinner and Overnight in Cappadocia.

October 14 - Cappadocia, Konya

Today, we are off to explore the Monastic Center of Goreme. Then, we will visit Ortahisar to see its gorgeous valleys and stop at the Three Beauties, the most famous of the region's iconic rock formations. We will also stop at Ozkonak Underground City. Then, we will hike through the valley of Zelve, see its hundreds of carved-from-rock houses and chapels, and visit Pasabag Valley, also known as Monk's Valley, to explore its tower-shaped hermitages. We will then end our day at the potter's studio in Avanos, a town established by the Hittites on the banks of the Halys River—dinner and Overnight in Konya.

October 15 - Konya, Pamukkale

After breakfast, drive to Pamukkale. We will visit the archeological remains of Hierapolis, an important site of early Christianity thanks to Paul's missionary efforts here. The city sits atop the travertine cascades of Pamukkale (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), Hierapolis became a healing center wherein the site's thermal pools were used to treat various ailments—dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

October 16 - Pamukkale, Ephesus, Kusadasi

Today, we will visit Ephesus, located in the modern town of Selcuk, ancient Ephesus is one of the most well-preserved archaeological sites in Turkey. Originally an ancient Greek

lonia city built in the 10th century BC, Ephesus became the largest metropolis and capital of the Roman province of Asia Minor. Then, we will visit the House of the Virgin Mary to see where the mother of Jesus is believed to have spent the last days of her life with the Apostle John—dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

October 17 - Kusadasi, Cannakkale

Day activities to be confirmed.

October 18 - Turkish Borders, Kavala

Then, we will cross the borders to meet our guide and driver to drive to Kavala for dinner and overnight.

October 19 - Philippi, Kavala

Today, we will drive along the ancient route of Apostle Paul to Amphipolis. In Philippi, Paul preached, established the first church in Europe. Next, continue to Kavala, the ancient port of Neapoli. Continue to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

October 20 - Thessaloniki

Today, we will enjoy this city, named after Alexander, the Great's sister, and which figures prominently in the New Testament. We will have a panoramic drive to the Old City Walls, where we have excellent views of the city and the opportunity to take pictures. During our driving tour, we see the White Tower, the Arch of Galerius, and the Rotunda standing on the Egnatian Way. We will visit the Byzantine church of St Demetrius—have dinner, and overnight in Thessaloniki.

October 21 - Thessaloniki, Veria, Kalambaka

This morning, stop in Veria (Beroea of

the New Testament). Visit the Bema of St Paul, where he is said to have stood and preached the Gospel to the local community. Continue to Kalambaka.

October 22 - Kalambaka, Meteora, Athens

In Meteora, we visit one or two monasteries situated atop vast rocks; the 14th-century monasteries compose one of the most breathtaking sites in the world. Inside the monasteries, discover many historical and religious treasures. Return to Athens.

October 23 - Corinth, Athens

Today, we will have a short drive to Corinth for a guided visit to where St. Paul worked for 18 months with tent makers Aquila and Priscilla. Return to Athens and enjoy sightseeing to visit the Acropolis with the Parthenon and Mars Hill, where Paul delivered his famous sermon about the identity of "the Unknown God". Dinner and overnight.

October 24 - Athens, 3 Islands cruise

Today, we will sail on a particular cruise for the three islands of Agina, Poros and Hydra, where we will enjoy delicious food, live music, and entertainment onboard. We will also enjoy the unique design of each island and have enough time for shopping or maybe little swimming. Lunch will be served onboard. Please return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 25 - Departure back home

Depart on flight TK9 at 9:55am to Istanbul, arriving at 11:20am. Transfer on flight at 1:15pm to Los Angeles, arriving at 4:55pm.
