


General Information

Beginning in August 2021, Iowa families will have online access to view their student's results on the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP). The **ISASP Parent Portal** will allow families to securely access and view the Individual Student Reports (ISR). Please note: students who took remote testing will not receive an ISR and will not have a report available in the portal.



Accessing the Portal

An access guide for families will be posted when the portal goes live. Here are the simplified steps to give you an idea of how the portal works.

- 1. Families will go to the ISASP Parent Portal and create an account.
- 2. After logging in to the portal, families can locate their student's ISR by entering the student's first name, last name, date of birth, and **Claim Code** in the box *Find Test Results*.
 - a. The student's information must be entered exactly as it is registered in PearsonAccess^{next}.
- 3. If all the information matches, the student's ISR will become available on the right side of the page. The scale scores and achievement levels will be displayed, along with a link to download a PDF file of the ISR.
- 4. For subsequent years of ISASP testing, families would log in to the portal and enter the student's information (along with a new claim code) in the box *Find Test Results*.

Claim Code

The claim code is a secure access code that Coordinators will find in PearsonAccess^{next}. The claim code will be available as a column in the Student Data File, which will be posted in August 2021 as part of the final published reports release. Schools and districts will need to determine a secure method to provide families with their student's claim code.

More information about the claim code will be available when the portal goes live.
