Gospel For The Thirteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time (June 26th)

Luke 9:51-62

OLG'S 75TH ANNIVERSARY A Memory of Our History

The Oakland Diocese was formed in 1962 for parishes in Alameda and Contra Costa counties that previously were part of the San Francisco



Diocese. Also in 1962, Castro Valley's growth led to the opening of the new parish of Transfiguration which encompassed parishioners of Our Lady of Grace living on the eastern side of Castro Valley. It was a sad parting. Msgr. Stack retired in 1972 and continued his residence at OLG until shortly before his death on March 3, 1984. In honor or Msgr. Stack, the hall was dedicated 'Stack Center'.


