

Marriage preparation sessions are mandatory for those preparing for marriage. **Cost is \$150.00 per couple.** 

Sessions run Friday @ 7-9pm and continue Saturday @ 9am-4pm. Follow up meetings with a Sponsor couple take place after the weekend on your own time.

**BAPTISM PREPARATION** Registration takes place at the Parish Office and a meeting is booked with one of our Parish Priests. A Baptism Preparation session is required for the baptism of your first child. Cost is \$20.

<u>Documents required:</u> \*Birth Certificate of child \*Baptism Certificate of parent(s) \*Annotated Baptismal Certificate of Godparent(s). This is a baptism certificate that shows date of Confirmation as well.

#### **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION**

Registration is ongoing for those interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith. Inquirers are instructed in the Catholic Faith and introduced to the life of the Church. The Rite of Christian Initiation is for those who would like to join the Catholic Church.

- So the <u>Eucharist</u> is also about PEOPLE.







## Catechumenal Itineraries for Married Life

The Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life on Wednesday released new pastoral guidelines for local Churches, which lay out a path toward the creation of "Catechumenal Itineraries for Married Life".

"The Church, in every age, is called to proclaim anew the beauty and abundance of grace contained in the Sacrament of Marriage and the family life which flows from it, especially to young people." says Pope Francis in the preface for the document. The pastoral guideline will advocate for lengthier, revamped marriage preparation.

The Document charts a path toward a true "catechumenate", based on the model of the ancient baptismal catechumenate for adults, in order to help them build their marriage on the rock of faith. Read more




