**Excerpt from May 27 letter from Bishop Daly:**

“The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is to be reinstated throughout the Diocese of Spokane beginning with the Vigil Mass for Corpus Christi on June 5th. As has always been the case, those who have a serious reason are exempt from the obligation to attend. He is a nationally recognized presenter and educator, and has over 40 years of experience with diversity training in the NW, including K-12.

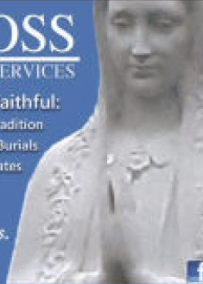
