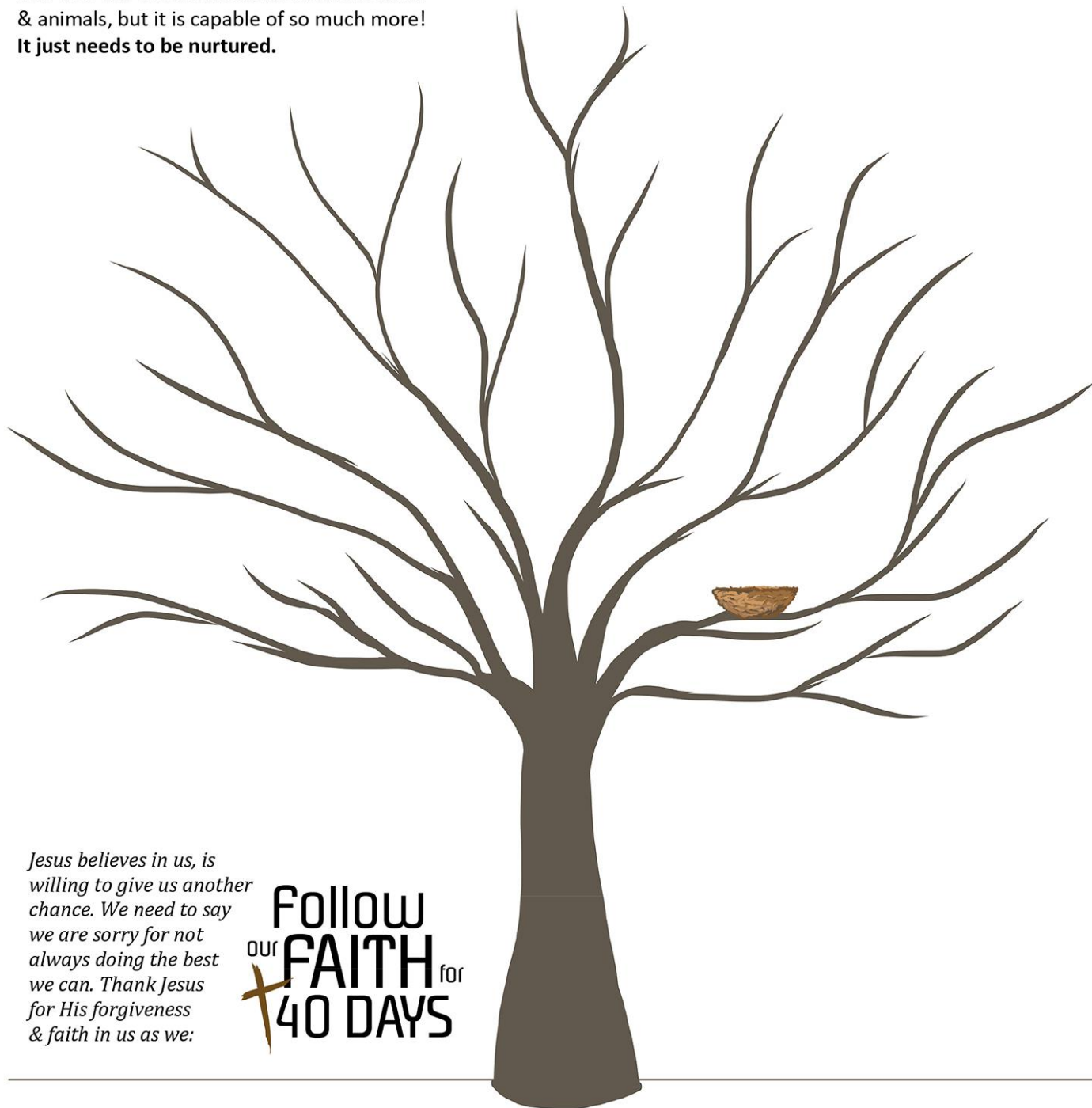
Third Sunday of Lent | Luke 13:1-9
