Fasting Guidelines: The Holy Canons specify the following from sundown of Cheesefare Sunday to Holy Pascha: Abstinence of meat including poultry, meat products, dairy products, fish, olive oil and wine. No Abstinence of shellfish, fruit, vegetables, and vegetable products. During this time, Orthodox Christians regulate both the amount of food they eat and the number of times they eat each day. In other words, no food should be eaten between meals and at mealtimes only a small portion of food should be eaten.

There will be no divine services during the daylight hours of Pascha (Sunday, April 5).
