June 2026

Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June 1

St. Justin (Memorial), Martyr

- Vestments: **Red**
- Prayers are proper and found in the Proper of Saints
- Preface I or II of Saints or Preface I or II of Holy Martyrs may be used.
- Prayer over the People no. 27 or no. 28 may be used.

June 2

Tuesday - 9th Week in Ordinary Time

June 3

St. Charles Lwanga and Companions, Martyrs (Memorial) Red

- Vestments: **Red**
- Prayers are proper and found in the Proper of Saints
- Preface I or II of Saints or Preface I or II of Holy Martyrs may be used.
- Prayer over the People no. 27 or no. 28 may be used.

June 4

Thursday - 9th Week in Ordinary Time

June 5

St. Boniface, Bishop & Martyr (Memorial) Red

- Vestments: **Red**
- Prayers are proper and found in the Proper of Saints
- Preface I or II of Saints; Preface I or II of Holy Martyrs; or Preface of Holy Pastors may be used.
- Prayer over the People no. 8 may be used.

June 6

Saturday - 9th Week in Ordinary Time

Permanent Diaconate Ordination

Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels at 9:00 AM.

- The Ordination will be streamed LIVE starting at 9:00 AM.

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June 7

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

- Mass texts are found in the section for solemnities and feasts of the Lord.
- Sprinkling Rite may be used.
- The *Gloria* is sung or recited.
- Optional Sequence, *Lauda Sion*, before the Gospel
- The Creed is said.
- Solemn Blessing #10 or Prayer over the People #9 may be used.
- Ritual Masses (i.e. Celebration of Matrimony) are not permitted.
- Funeral Masses are permitted.
- You may commission the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion today. Please see *Book of Blessings*, Chapter 63.
- *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass*, no. 102 is the guiding document to reference for this devotion and other forms of devotion toward the Eucharist.
- If there is a Eucharistic Procession following immediately after the Mass, the normal concluding rites are omitted and there is no recessional hymn.
- Children who have made their First Communion could be invited to join in the procession.
- Parishioners are invited after Mass to pray the Litany of the Most Blessed Sacrament, written by St. Peter Julian Eymard, the founder of the Blessed Sacrament Fathers. or publish the litany on the parish website or bulletin.

- Vestments: **Red**
- Prayers are proper and found in the Proper of Saints
- Preface of the Apostles I or II may be used.
- Prayer over the People no. 23 may be used.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on **June 11, 2026**, and invite all parishes to join in this consecration.

Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests

- Vestments: **White**
- The prayers, including the preface, are proper and found in the section for Solemnities of the Lord.
- The *Gloria* is said or sung.
- The Creed is said.

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- Collect from the Votive Mass of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus may be used.
- Parishioners are invited after Mass to pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus or publish the litany on the parish website or bulletin.
- Solemn Blessing no. 13 may be used.

June 13

Immaculate Heart of Mary - *Optional Memorial*

- Vestments: **White**
- Prayers are found in the *Roman Missal* Proper of the Saints at the end of the section of May.
- Prayers are also found in the *Collection of Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary*, no. 28 "Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary."
- The *Gloria* is not sung or said.
- Readings: Lectionary #573.
- The Creed is not said.
- Preface I or II of the Blessed Virgin Mary may be used.
- Solemn Blessing no. 15 may be used.

June 14

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fathers' Day

- Without diminishing the primacy of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, remember that it is also Father's Day.
- A special blessing may be given to Fathers. The blessing is available in the Book of Blessings, Chapter 56, "Order of Blessing for Fathers on Father's Day."
 - For those who are fathers, we ask for wisdom and humility in the face of the task of parenting. Give them the strength to do well by their children and by You, **We pray to the Lord.**

- The Creed is said

Solemnity of Saints Peter & Paul, Apostles

- Vestments: **Red**
- Prayers are proper and found in the Proper of the Saints
- The *Gloria* is said or sung.
- The Creed is said.
- Solemn Blessing #16 may be used.
- A Vigil Mass may be celebrated on June 28, either before or after Evening Prayer I of the Solemnity.

 - Readings for the Mass of the Day

- Mass proper is found in the Proper of Pastors
- Use Preface of Holy Pastors

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July 3

Feast St. Thomas the Apostle

- Liturgical Color: **RED**
- Mass proper is found in the Proper of Saints
- Sprinkling rite may be used for the feast of an apostle
- *Gloria* is said or sung
- Creed is not said.
- Use Preface I or II of the Apostles
- Solemn Blessing #17 may be used.

July 4th Morning Masses

Independence Day

- Mass proper is found in the Proper of Saints.
- Liturgical Color: **White**
- When the Mass for Independence Day is used, the *Gloria* should be either said or sung.
- Creed is not said.
- Readings may be taken from Lectionary Vol. IV #882-886, #887-891
- **Pastoral Note:** For the general intercessions, one may use the adaptation of the prayer composed by Archbishop John Carroll for the inauguration of George Washington, as found in *Book of Blessings*, no. 1965. See also *Handbook of Blessings*, 176.
- Music: The following hymns such as *America the Beautiful*, *My Country 'Tis of Thee*, *God Bless America*, *Faith of Our Fathers*, *Battle Hymn Republic*, as well as those found in various hymnals may be reserved for use during the Recessional or Postlude.
- Independence Day may also be appropriately acknowledged in the Homily, Universal Prayer, and closing hymn during the liturgy.
- Solemn Blessing found in the Mass proper for Independence Day.

July 4th Evening Masses

- **The Anticipatory Mass celebrated after 4PM will be the Mass for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time**
- **Pastoral Note:** For the general intercessions, one may use the adaptation of the prayer composed by Archbishop John Carroll for the inauguration of George Washington, as found in *Book of Blessings*, no. 1965. See also *Handbook of Blessings*, 176.
- Music: The following hymns such as *America the Beautiful*, *My Country 'Tis of Thee*, *God Bless America*, *Faith of Our Fathers*, *Battle Hymn Republic*, as well as those found in various hymnals may be reserved for use during the Recessional or Postlude.

- *Gloria* is said or sung.
- Creed is omitted.
- On June 3, 2016, the Holy See raised the liturgical rank of the **Memorial of Saint Mary Magdalene** to a **FEAST**, with the date remaining on **July 22**.
- A new Preface before the Eucharistic Prayer for the Feast was also promulgated in Latin. The English translation of the new Preface before the Eucharist Prayer may be used beginning in 2020.

- Mass proper found in the Proper of Saints
- Liturgical Color: **RED**
- *Gloria* is said or sung.
- Creed is omitted.
- Preface I or II of the Apostles are used.
- Solemn Blessing #17 may be used.
