

BAPTISM OF CHILDREN:

Parents must be registered in the parish and participate in a parent preparation class. A preparation session is held every other month. You must RSVP in advance; this can be done on our website or by calling the parish office.

CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS:

Adults interested in becoming Catholic are always welcomed. For more information on the RCIA process, please visit our website or call the parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples planning to be married at St. Elizabeth must contact one of our parish priests before a wedding date is set and at least six months in advance. Participation in a preparation program is required.

SICK CALLS:

Please notify the parish office as soon as possible with information about anyone who is hospitalized, sick, or homebound and who may wish to be visited by a priest or a Eucharistic Minister.

SUPPORTING YOUR PARISH:

Secure automatic giving is provided to our parish through FaithDirect. Please visit www.faithdirect.net to enroll online, or call toll free (1-866-507-8757). Our parish code is MD19. (Note that enrollment in FaithDirect does NOT automatically register you in the parish. Please call the parish office for details.)

PARISH MEMBERSHIP:

We ask that if you wish to make this your parish home that you please fill out the online registration form by going to **stelizabethchurchmd.org/registration**. You must be registered to receive **certification letters of eligibility for baptism, to be married in the Church, to be a sponsor for confirmation, to be a godparent,** or to receive sacramental preparation. You should be registered to enroll in Saint Elizabeth School or the Religious Education Program. If you are over the age of 21 and have previously been registered as part of your parents' household, we ask that you register under your own name. We ask that you notify the parish office if your family status changes, including any contact information, or if you move out of the area.

Parish Support for So Others Might Eat

After a five month break due to COVID-19 St. Elizabeth resumed its longstanding (since 1978) "second Saturday of the month" outreach to SOME in September. Under SOME's modified Provide-A- Meal program, we deliver food donated at St. Elizabeth for a chicken based luncheon meal but do not stay to help prepare and serve the meal. Our latest substantial supply of chicken and other requested food was delivered to SOME on November 14. Despite the public health challenges it has faced this year, SOME has modified its services in ways that enabled a continuous provision of essential services to meet the huge needs of its many clients. SOME's quarterly report notes that so far this year it has served 140,801 nutritious meals to hungry people. 236 families (690 individuals including 480 children) continue to be safely housed in SOME's affordable housing. And part of its response to COVID 19, SOME has also distributed 9,416 masks to vulnerable residents, distributed 29,560 pounds of food, completed 7,552 hours of online learning, and completed 29,719 wellness checks.


